bag	A woman s handbag. <i>His bag now is learning to play golf.</i>
baroque	Relating to or denoting a style of European architecture music and art of the 17th and 18th centuries that followed Mannerism and is characterized by ornate detail In architecture the period is exemplified by the palace of Versailles and by the work of Wren in England Major composers include Vivaldi Bach and Handel Caravaggio and Rubens are important baroque artists. <i>The candles were positively baroque.</i>
beaded	Decorated or covered with beads. <i>Beaded chiffon dresses.</i>
checked	Patterned with alternating squares of color. <i>A checked shirt.</i>
checkered	Patterned with alternating squares of color. <i>A checkered business career.</i>
cloth	A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e g a dishcloth or a tablecloth. <i>Has he given up all ideas of the cloth.</i>
cotton	Thread made of cotton fibers. <i>A white cotton blouse.</i>
decorated	Provided with something intended to increase its beauty or distinction.
decorative	Relating to decoration. <i>A decorative artist.</i>
dotted	Marked with or in the form of dots. <i>A dotted minim.</i>
embroidery	Elaboration of an interpretation by the use of decorative (sometimes fictitious) detail. <i>Fanciful embroidery of the facts.</i>

fabric	The underlying structure. <i>The multicultural fabric of Canadian society.</i>
fancy	Have a fancy or particular liking or desire for. <i>Fancy hotels and restaurants.</i>
floral	A fabric with a floral design. <i>An unusual floral design.</i>
linen	White goods or clothing made with linen cloth. <i>A linen suit.</i>
material	Having material or physical form or substance. <i>Material living standards have risen.</i>
mosaic	Decorate with a mosaic. <i>The digital data were combined or mosaicked to delineate counties.</i>
pattern	Form a pattern. <i>Make a pattern for the zigzag edge.</i>
patterned	Having patterns (especially colorful patterns). <i>She wore leather trousers and a patterned shirt.</i>
plume	Form a plume. <i>The antennae are divided into large feathery plumes.</i>
preen	Pride or congratulate (oneself) for an achievement. <i>It did not prevent them from preening themselves on their achievement.</i>
print	A piece of fabric or clothing with a coloured pattern or design printed on it. <i>A beetle scurried by printing tracks in the sand with its busy feet.</i>
rococo	The rococo style of art decoration or architecture. <i>An exquisite gilded rococo mirror.</i>
speckle	Mark with a large number of small spots or patches of colour. <i>It has white speckles on its forewing.</i>
spotted	Marked or decorated with spots. <i>A red spotted handkerchief.</i>
striped	Marked with or having stripes. <i>A green striped coat.</i>
tessellated	Having a checkered or mottled appearance. <i>The hotel has a tessellated facade of coloured glass.</i>
texture	Give something a rough or uneven texture. <i>Skin texture and tone.</i>
variegated	Marked by variety. <i>Variegated yellow bricks.</i>
vase	An open jar of glass or porcelain used as an ornament or to hold flowers.
