## Associations of "Figured" (30 Words)

<b>bag</b>	A woman s handbag. <i>His <b>bag</b> now is learning to play golf.</i>
<b>baroque</b>	Relating to or denoting a style of European architecture music and art of the 17th and 18th centuries that followed Mannerism and is characterized by ornate detail In architecture the period is exemplified by the palace of Versailles and by the work of Wren in England Major composers include Vivaldi Bach and Handel Caravaggio and Rubens are important baroque artists. <i>The candles were positively <b>baroque</b>.</i>
<b>beaded</b>	Decorated or covered with beads. <i><b>Beaded</b> chiffon dresses.</i>
<b>checked</b>	Patterned with alternating squares of color. <i>A <b>checked</b> shirt.</i>
<b>checkered</b>	Patterned with alternating squares of color. <i>A <b>checkered</b> business career.</i>
<b>cloth</b>	A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e g a dishcloth or a tablecloth. <i>Has he given up all ideas of the <b>cloth</b>.</i>
<b>cotton</b>	Thread made of cotton fibers. <i>A white <b>cotton</b> blouse.</i>
<b>decorated</b>	Provided with something intended to increase its beauty or distinction.
<b>decorative</b>	Relating to decoration. <i>A <b>decorative</b> artist.</i>
<b>dotted</b>	Marked with or in the form of dots. <i>A <b>dotted</b> minim.</i>
<b>embroidery</b>	Elaboration of an interpretation by the use of decorative (sometimes fictitious) detail. <i>Fanciful <b>embroidery</b> of the facts.</i>

<b>fabric</b>	The underlying structure. <i>The multicultural <b>fabric</b> of Canadian society.</i>
<b>fancy</b>	Have a fancy or particular liking or desire for. <i><b>Fancy</b> hotels and restaurants.</i>
<b>floral</b>	A fabric with a floral design. <i>An unusual <b>floral</b> design.</i>
<b>linen</b>	White goods or clothing made with linen cloth. <i>A <b>linen</b> suit.</i>
<b>material</b>	Having material or physical form or substance. <i><b>Material</b> living standards have risen.</i>
<b>mosaic</b>	Decorate with a mosaic. <i>The digital data were combined or <b>mosaicked</b> to delineate counties.</i>
<b>pattern</b>	Form a pattern. <i>Make a <b>pattern</b> for the zigzag edge.</i>
<b>patterned</b>	Having patterns (especially colorful patterns). <i>She wore leather trousers and a <b>patterned</b> shirt.</i>
<b>plume</b>	Form a plume. <i>The antennae are divided into large feathery <b>plumes</b>.</i>
<b>preen</b>	Pride or congratulate (oneself) for an achievement. <i>It did not prevent them from <b>preening</b> themselves on their achievement.</i>
<b>print</b>	A piece of fabric or clothing with a coloured pattern or design printed on it. <i>A beetle scurried by <b>printing</b> tracks in the sand with its busy feet.</i>
<b>rococo</b>	The rococo style of art decoration or architecture. <i>An exquisite gilded <b>rococo</b> mirror.</i>
<b>speckle</b>	Mark with a large number of small spots or patches of colour. <i>It has white <b>speckles</b> on its forewing.</i>
<b>spotted</b>	Marked or decorated with spots. <i>A red <b>spotted</b> handkerchief.</i>
<b>striped</b>	Marked with or having stripes. <i>A green <b>striped</b> coat.</i>
<b>tessellated</b>	Having a checkered or mottled appearance. <i>The hotel has a <b>tessellated</b> facade of coloured glass.</i>
<b>texture</b>	Give something a rough or uneven texture. <i>Skin <b>texture</b> and tone.</i>
<b>variegated</b>	Marked by variety. <i><b>Variegated</b> yellow bricks.</i>
<b>vase</b>	An open jar of glass or porcelain used as an ornament or to hold flowers.
