| <b>delineation</b>               | Representation by drawing or painting etc.<br><i>The eventual <b>delineation</b> of the border between the two states.</i>                           |
| <a href="#">depiction</a>        | The action of depicting something, especially in a work of art.<br><i>The painting s horrific <b>depiction</b> of war.</i>                           |
| <b>gargoyle</b>                  | An ornament consisting of a grotesquely carved figure of a person or animal.   |

| <b>nominal</b>          | A phrase that can function as the subject or object of a verb.<br><i>The <b>nominal</b> exchange rate.</i>   |
| <b>oblique</b>          | An oblique muscle.<br><i>Acute and obtuse angles are <b>oblique</b> angles.</i>  |
| <b>painter</b>          | An artist who paints pictures.<br><i>A self employed <b>painter</b> and decorator.</i>   |
| <b>photography</b>      | The art or practice of taking and processing photographs.  |
| <b>picture</b>          | Represent in a photograph or picture.<br><i>Poor <b>picture</b> quality.</i>   |
| <b><u>portrait</u></b>  | A word picture of a person's appearance and character.<br><i>A <b>portrait</b> painter.</i>  |
| <b>portraiture</b>      | A word picture of a person's appearance and character.<br><i>His strength as a novelist lay in his <b>portraiture</b> of upper class families.</i> |
| <b>portrayal</b>        | A representation by picture or portraiture.<br><i>His <b>portrayal</b> of the title character.</i>   |
| <b>sculpt</b>           | Create by shaping stone or wood or any other hard material.<br><i>She was teaching him how to <b>sculpt</b>.</i>                                   |
| <b>sculptor</b>         | An artist who makes sculptures.  |
| <b><u>sculpture</u></b> | Form or shape as if by sculpture especially with strong smooth curves.<br><i>The choir stalls were each carefully <b>sculptured</b>.</i>           |
| <b>statuary</b>         | A sculptor.<br><i>Classical <b>statuary</b>.</i>   |
| <b><u>statue</u></b>    | A carved or cast figure of a person or animal, especially one that is life-size or larger.   |
| <b>statuesque</b>       | Of size and dignity suggestive of a statue.<br><i>Her <b>statuesque</b> beauty.</i>  |
| <b>vandalism</b>        | Action involving deliberate destruction of or damage to public or private property.<br><i>An act of mindless <b>vandalism</b>.</i>                 |
| <b>woodwork</b>         | The activity or skill of making things from wood.<br><i>He taught <b>woodwork</b> at night school.</i>   |
