Present Tense	find / finds
Past Tense	found or fand (dialectal)
Present Participle	finding
Past Participle	found or (archaic) founden

Conjugate Find

Find in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I find	We find
You find	You find
He/She/It finds	They find

Find in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am finding	We are finding
You are finding	You are finding
He/She/It is finding	They are finding

Find in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have found or (archaic) founden	We have found or (archaic) founden
You have found or (archaic) founden	You have found or (archaic) founden
He/She/It has found or (archaic) founden	They have found or (archaic) founden

Find in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been finding	We have been finding
You have been finding	You have been finding
He/She/It has been finding	They have been finding

Find in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I found or fand (dialectal)	We found or fand (dialectal)
You found or fand (dialectal)	You found or fand (dialectal)
He/She/It found or fand (dialectal)	They found or fand (dialectal)

Find in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was finding We were finding
You were finding You were finding
He/She/It was finding They were finding

Find in Past Perfect Tense

I had found or (archaic) founden We had found or (archaic) founden
You had found or (archaic) founden You had found or (archaic) founden
He/She/It had found or (archaic) founden They had found or (archaic) founden

Find in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

I had been finding We had been finding
You had been finding You had been finding
He/She/It had been finding They had been finding

Find in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will find We will find
You will find You will find
He/She/It will find They will find

Find in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be finding We will be finding
You will be finding You will be finding
He/She/It will be finding They will be finding

We will have found or (archaic) founden

I will have been finding

You will have been finding

He/She/It will have been finding

Plural

We will have been finding

You will have been finding

They will have been finding
