descant Sing in descant.

diatonic Of a melody or harmony constructed from a diatonic scale.

euphonyThe tendency to make phonetic change for ease of pronunciation.

The poet put **euphony** before mere factuality.



A stringed instrument usually having six strings; played by strumming or guitar

plucking.

The quality of forming a pleasing and consistent whole. harmony

The piece owes its air of tranquillity largely to the **harmony**.

mazurka Music composed for dancing the mazurka.

The principal part in harmonized music. melody
