| above | (in writing) at an earlier place. <i>The two cases described above.</i> |
| ahead | Leading or ahead in a competition. <i>I see the lights of a town ahead.</i> |
| antecedence | Preceding in time. |
| before | Earlier in time; previously. <i>They began trotting through the city with guards running before and behind.</i> |
| beforehand | Before an action or event; in advance. <i>Rooms must be booked beforehand.</i> |
| betimes | Before the usual or expected time; early. <i>Next morning I was up betimes.</i> |
| eighth | One part in eight equal parts. |
| eleventh | Position 11 in a countable series of things. |
| fifth | A quantity of liquor equal to one fifth of a United States gallon. <i>He was fifth out of several hundred runners.</i> |
| five | A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips. |
| forego | Be earlier in time; go back further. |
| forward | Forward in time or order or degree. <i>A forward child badly in need of discipline.</i> |
| fourth | In the fourth place. <i>Fourthly you must pay the rent on the first of the month.</i> |
| front | Provide something with a front or facing of a particular type or material. <i>Parents get a bit worried if you don't front up now and then.</i> |
| ninth | One part in nine equal parts. <i>Going into the ninth they were a run ahead.</i> |

| <u>precede</u> | Be the predecessor of. <i>Stone tools precede bronze tools.</i> |
| <u>preceding</u> | Existing or coming before. <i>The preceding pages.</i> |
| predate | Prey on or hunt for. <i>These mammals predate certain eggs.</i> |
| prefatory | Serving as an introduction or preface. <i>In his prefatory remarks the author claims that.</i> |
| prematurely | Before the end of the normal period of gestation. <i>His son died prematurely.</i> |
| <u>prior</u> | The head of a religious order in an abbey the prior is next below the abbot. <i>He had no juvenile record no priors.</i> |
| quintuple | Five times as much or as many. <i>The company s revenues would quintuple over the next decade.</i> |
| <u>second</u> | In the second place. <i>Second we must consider the economy.</i> |
| seventh | The musical interval between one note and another seven notes away from it. |
| six | Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units. |
| sixth | The musical interval between one note and another six notes away from it. |
| tenth | A tenth part one part in ten equal parts. |
| third | In the third place. <i>It contains approximately a third of the minimum daily requirement.</i> |
| twenty | Denoting a quantity consisting of 20 items or units. |
| untimely | At a time that is unsuitable or premature. <i>His untimely death in military action.</i> |
