<b>above</b>	Appearing earlier in the same text. <i>Flaws in the <b>above</b> interpretation.</i>
<b>ahead</b>	Leading or ahead in a competition. <i>Staring straight <b>ahead</b>.</i>
<b>antecedence</b>	Preceding in time.
<b>anterior</b>	Pronounced with an obstruction located in front of the palato-alveolar region of the mouth, e.g. b, p, d, t. <i>His malocclusion was caused by malposed <b>anterior</b>s.</i>
<b>before</b>	Earlier in time; previously. <i>I had known her <b>before</b>.</i>
<b>betimes</b>	In good time. <i>Next morning I was up <b>betimes</b>.</i>
<b>eighth</b>	One part in eight equal parts.
<b>eleventh</b>	Position 11 in a countable series of things.
<b>fifth</b>	A quantity of liquor equal to one fifth of a United States gallon. <i>He was <b>fifth</b> out of several hundred runners.</i>
<b>forego</b>	Do without or cease to hold or adhere to.
<b>forward</b>	In a forward direction. <i>The captain went fore or <b>forward</b> to check the instruments.</i>
<b>fourth</b>	In the fourth place. <i><b>Fourthly</b> you must pay the rent on the first of the month.</i>
<b>front</b>	Provide something with a front or facing of a particular type or material. <i>Parents get a bit worried if you don't <b>front</b> up now and then.</i>
<b>henceforth</b>	From this or that time on. <i><b>Henceforth</b> she will be known as Mrs Smith.</i>
<b>ninth</b>	Position nine in a countable series of things. <i>Going into the <b>ninth</b> they were a run ahead.</i>

<b><u>precede</u></b>	Be the predecessor of. <i>He <b>preceded</b> the book with a collection of poems.</i>
<b><u>preceding</u></b>	Of a person who has held and relinquished a position or office. <i>A growth in sales above those of the <b>preceding</b> year.</i>
<b>predate</b>	Exist or occur at a date earlier than (something). <i>Here parish boundaries seem clearly to <b>predate</b> Roman roads.</i>
<b>prefatory</b>	Serving as an introduction or preface. <i>In his <b>prefatory</b> remarks the author claims that.</i>
<b>prematurely</b>	Before the due time; ahead of time. <i>I spoke <b>prematurely</b>.</i>
<b>previous</b>	Previous convictions a criminal record. <i>She looked tired after her exertions of the <b>previous</b> evening.</i>
<b><u>prior</u></b>	The head of a religious order in an abbey the prior is next below the abbot. <i>He had no juvenile record no <b>priors</b>.</i>
<b>quintuple</b>	Increase or cause to increase fivefold. <i>The population of China <b>quintupled</b>.</i>
<b><u>secondly</u></b>	In the second place. <i>He was presented first of all as a hopelessly unqualified candidate and <b>secondly</b> as an extremist.</i>
<b>seventh</b>	Coming next after the sixth and just before the eighth in position.
<b>sixth</b>	Position six in a countable series of things.
<b>tenth</b>	A tenth part one part in ten equal parts.
<b>third</b>	In the third place. <i>He was cut down on a close play at <b>third</b>.</i>
<b>twenty</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of nineteen and one.
<b>untimely</b>	(of a death or end) happening too soon or sooner than normal. <i>Alcohol brought him to an <b>untimely</b> end.</i>
