above	Appearing earlier in the same text. <i>Flaws in the above interpretation.</i>
ahead	Leading or ahead in a competition. <i>Staring straight ahead.</i>
antecedence	Preceding in time.
anterior	Pronounced with an obstruction located in front of the palato-alveolar region of the mouth, e.g. b, p, d, t. <i>His malocclusion was caused by malposed anteriors.</i>
before	Earlier in time; previously. <i>I had known her before.</i>
betimes	In good time. <i>Next morning I was up betimes.</i>
eighth	One part in eight equal parts.
eleventh	Position 11 in a countable series of things.
fifth	A quantity of liquor equal to one fifth of a United States gallon. <i>He was fifth out of several hundred runners.</i>
forego	Do without or cease to hold or adhere to.
forward	In a forward direction. <i>The captain went fore or forward to check the instruments.</i>
fourth	In the fourth place. <i>Fourthly you must pay the rent on the first of the month.</i>
front	Provide something with a front or facing of a particular type or material. <i>Parents get a bit worried if you don't front up now and then.</i>
henceforth	From this or that time on. <i>Henceforth she will be known as Mrs Smith.</i>
ninth	Position nine in a countable series of things. <i>Going into the ninth they were a run ahead.</i>

<u>precede</u>	Be the predecessor of. <i>He preceded the book with a collection of poems.</i>
<u>preceding</u>	Of a person who has held and relinquished a position or office. <i>A growth in sales above those of the preceding year.</i>
predate	Exist or occur at a date earlier than (something). <i>Here parish boundaries seem clearly to predate Roman roads.</i>
prefatory	Serving as an introduction or preface. <i>In his prefatory remarks the author claims that.</i>
prematurely	Before the due time; ahead of time. <i>I spoke prematurely.</i>
previous	Previous convictions a criminal record. <i>She looked tired after her exertions of the previous evening.</i>
<u>prior</u>	The head of a religious order in an abbey the prior is next below the abbot. <i>He had no juvenile record no priors.</i>
quintuple	Increase or cause to increase fivefold. <i>The population of China quintupled.</i>
<u>secondly</u>	In the second place. <i>He was presented first of all as a hopelessly unqualified candidate and secondly as an extremist.</i>
seventh	Coming next after the sixth and just before the eighth in position.
sixth	Position six in a countable series of things.
tenth	A tenth part one part in ten equal parts.
third	In the third place. <i>He was cut down on a close play at third.</i>
twenty	The cardinal number that is the sum of nineteen and one.
untimely	(of a death or end) happening too soon or sooner than normal. <i>Alcohol brought him to an untimely end.</i>
