
Fishy as an Adjective

- Not as expected.
- Of or relating to or resembling fish.





Synonyms of "Fishy" as an adjective (8 Words)

Improbable. doubtful

He looked doubtful but gave a nod.

Open to doubt or suspicion. **dubious**

Extremely **dubious** assumptions.

Difficult to explain or understand; strange or odd. **funny**

Stealing other people s work isn t funny.

piscine Of or concerning fish.

Likely to be dishonourable or morally suspect. questionable It is questionable whether any of these exceptions is genuine.

Filled with shade. **shady**

A **shady** part of town.

Not as expected. **suspect**

A **suspect** package was found on the platform.



suspicious Having or showing a cautious distrust of someone or something. *He was suspicious* of her motives.



Usage Examples of "Fishy" as an adjective

- A fishy smell.
- I'm convinced there is something fishy going on.
- There was something fishy about the accident.
