Definitions of "Fishy" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “fishy” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Arousing feelings of doubt or suspicion.*
- *Relating to or resembling fish or a fish.*
- *Not as expected.*
- *Of or relating to or resembling fish.*



Synonyms of "Fishy" as an adjective (8 Words)

doubtful	Improbable. <i>He looked doubtful but gave a nod.</i>
dubious	Open to doubt or suspicion. <i>Extremely dubious assumptions.</i>
funny	Difficult to explain or understand; strange or odd. <i>Stealing other people s work isn t funny.</i>
piscine	Of or concerning fish.
questionable	Likely to be dishonourable or morally suspect. <i>It is questionable whether any of these exceptions is genuine.</i>
shady	Filled with shade. <i>A shady part of town.</i>
suspect	Not as expected. <i>A suspect package was found on the platform.</i>

suspicious

Having or showing a cautious distrust of someone or something.
*He was **suspicious** of her motives.*



Usage Examples of "Fishy" as an adjective

- *A fishy smell.*
- *I'm convinced there is something fishy going on.*
- *There was something fishy about the accident.*
