## Associations of "Fit in" (30 Words)

<b>acceptable</b>	Judged to be in conformity with approved usage. <i>Some coffee would be most <b>acceptable</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><b>adapt</b></a>	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>The policies can be <b>adapted</b> to suit individual needs.</i>
<b>adaption</b>	The process of adapting to something (such as environmental conditions).
<a href="#"><b>apposite</b></a>	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>The successful copywriter is a master of <b>apposite</b> and evocative verbal images.</i>
<b>appropriate</b>	Suitable or proper in the circumstances. <i>The accused had <b>appropriated</b> the property.</i>
<b>compatibility</b>	A feeling of sympathetic understanding. <i>He argues for the <b>compatibility</b> of science and religion.</i>
<b>compatible</b>	Able to exist and perform in harmonious or agreeable combination. <i>The printer is fully <b>compatible</b> with all leading software.</i>
<b>conformance</b>	Correspondence in form or appearance. <i><b>Conformance</b> to international standards.</i>
<b>conforming</b>	Adhering to established customs or doctrines (especially in religion).
<b>congruous</b>	Corresponding in character or kind. <i>This explanation is <b>congruous</b> with earlier observations.</i>
<a href="#"><b>conversion</b></a>	An event that results in a transformation. <i>You ll see better <b>conversion</b> rates for your local advertising if you include your physical address on your website.</i>
<b>convert</b>	A person who has been converted to another religious or political belief. <i>The substance <b>converts</b> to an acid.</i>

<b>correct</b>	Correct in opinion or judgment. <i>Motorists can have their headlights tested and <b>corrected</b> at a reduced price on Saturday.</i>
<b><u>correspond</u></b>	Be analogous or equivalent in character, form, or function. <i>Communication is successful when the ideas in the minds of the speaker and hearer <b>correspond</b>.</i>
<b>eligible</b>	(of a person) desirable or suitable as a partner in marriage. <i><b>Eligible</b> candidates.</i>
<b>germane</b>	Relevant and appropriate. <i>He asks questions that are <b>germane</b> and central to the issue.</i>
<b>harmonious</b>	Free from disagreement or dissent. <i>The tailored clothes were <b>harmonious</b> with her military bearing.</i>
<b><u>identical</u></b>	(of twins) developed from a single fertilized ovum, and therefore of the same sex and usually very similar in appearance. <i>Cars <b>identical</b> except for their license plates.</i>
<b>perfect</b>	A tense of verbs used in describing action that has been completed sometimes regarded as perfective aspect. <i>Equity will not <b>perfect</b> an <b>imperfect</b> gift.</i>
<b>perfectly</b>	Used for emphasis, especially in order to assert something that has been challenged or doubted. <i>The ring fitted <b>perfectly</b>.</i>
<b>pertinent</b>	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>A list of articles <b>pertinent</b> to the discussion.</i>
<b><u>propriety</u></b>	The condition of being right, appropriate, or fitting. <i>He always behaved with the utmost <b>propriety</b>.</i>
<b>rearrange</b>	Change (the position, time, or order of something). <i>She <b>rearranged</b> her skirt as she sat back in her chair.</i>
<b><u>relevant</u></b>	Closely connected or appropriate to what is being done or considered. <i>Critics may find themselves unable to stay <b>relevant</b> in a changing world.</i>
<b>right</b>	In the right manner. <i>That sausage doesn't smell <b>right</b>.</i>
<b>snug</b>	Fitting closely but comfortably. <i>A <b>snug</b> house.</i>
<b><u>suitable</u></b>	Right or appropriate for a particular person, purpose, or situation. <i>A tractor <b>suitable</b> or fit for heavy duty.</i>
<b>symphonic</b>	Relating to or characteristic or suggestive of a symphony. <i>The <b>symphonic</b> hum of a million insects.</i>

**unexceptionable** Completely acceptable; not open to exception or reproach.  
*A judge's ethics should be **unexceptionable**.*

**unobjectionable** Not causing disapproval.  
***Unobjectionable** behavior.*
