Infinitive	<b>to flack</b>
Present Tense	<b>flack / flacks</b>
Past Tense	<b>flacked</b>
Present Participle	<b>flacking</b>
Past Participle	<b>flacked</b>

## Conjugate Flack

**Flack in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>flack</b>	We <b>flack</b>
You <b>flack</b>	You <b>flack</b>
He/She/It <b>flacks</b>	They <b>flack</b>

## **Flack in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am flacking</b>	We <b>are flacking</b>
You <b>are flacking</b>	You <b>are flacking</b>
He/She/It <b>is flacking</b>	They <b>are flacking</b>

## **Flack in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have flacked</b>	We <b>have flacked</b>
You <b>have flacked</b>	You <b>have flacked</b>
He/She/It <b>has flacked</b>	They <b>have flacked</b>

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been flacking</b>	We <b>have been flacking</b>
You <b>have been flacking</b>	You <b>have been flacking</b>
He/She/It <b>has been flacking</b>	They <b>have been flacking</b>

I <b>flacked</b>	We <b>flacked</b>
You <b>flacked</b>	You <b>flacked</b>
He/She/It <b>flacked</b>	They <b>flacked</b>

I <b>was flacking</b>	We <b>were flacking</b>
You <b>were flacking</b>	You <b>were flacking</b>
He/She/It <b>was flacking</b>	They <b>were flacking</b>

I <b>had flacked</b>	We <b>had flacked</b>
You <b>had flacked</b>	You <b>had flacked</b>
He/She/It <b>had flacked</b>	They <b>had flacked</b>

**Flack in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been flacking</b>	We <b>had been flacking</b>
You <b>had been flacking</b>	You <b>had been flacking</b>
He/She/It <b>had been flacking</b>	They <b>had been flacking</b>

I <b>will flack</b>	We <b>will flack</b>
You <b>will flack</b>	You <b>will flack</b>
He/She/It <b>will flack</b>	They <b>will flack</b>

I <b>will be flacking</b>	We <b>will be flacking</b>
You <b>will be flacking</b>	You <b>will be flacking</b>
He/She/It <b>will be flacking</b>	They <b>will be flacking</b>

**Flack in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have flacked**

**We will have flacked**

**You will have flacked**

**You will have flacked**

**He/She/It will have flacked**

**They will have flacked**

**Flack in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been flacking**

**We will have been flacking**

**You will have been flacking**

**You will have been flacking**

**He/She/It will have been flacking**

**They will have been flacking**
