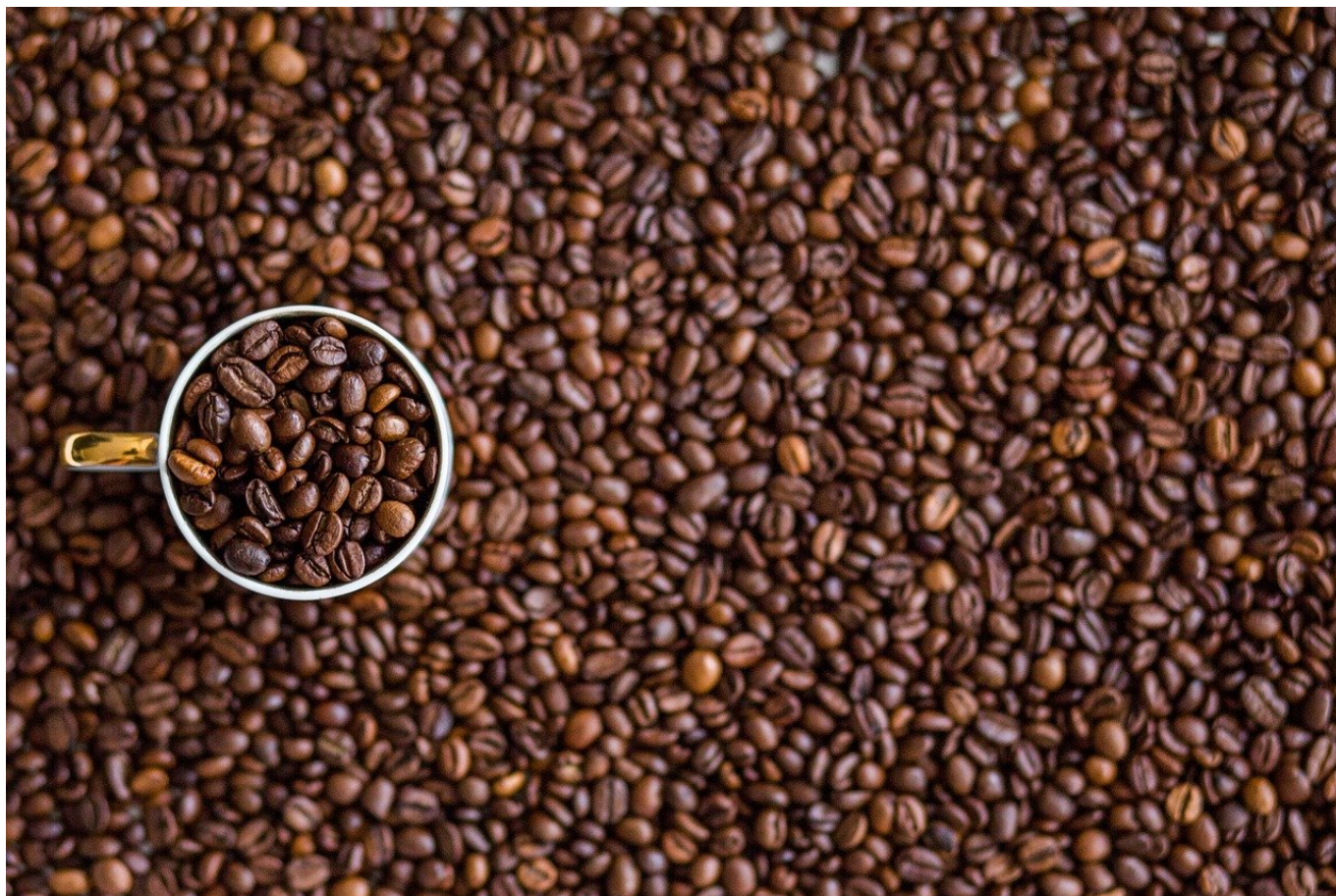

<b>flavourous</b>	Full of flavor.
<b>flavoursome</b>	(of food or drink) having a pleasant, distinct flavour; tasty. <i>An incredibly rich and <b>flavoursome</b> dish.</i>
<b>sapid</b>	Full of flavor. <i>The aromatic stew was just as <b>sapid</b> as it smelled.</i>
<b>saporous</b>	Full of flavor.

<b>gustatory</b>	Concerned with tasting or the sense of taste. <i><b>Gustatory</b> delights.</i>
<u><b>luscious</b></u>	(of food or drink) having a pleasingly rich, sweet taste. <i>A <b>luscious</b> and fragrant dessert wine.</i>
<b>musky</b>	Resembling the smell of musk.
<b>odoriferous</b>	Having or giving off a smell, especially an unpleasant one. <i>An <b>odoriferous</b> pile of fish.</i>
<b>odorous</b>	Having or giving off an odour. <i><b>Odorous</b> garbage.</i>
<u><b>palatable</b></u>	(of an action or proposal) acceptable or satisfactory. <i>A <b>palatable</b> solution to the problem.</i>
<u><b>perfume</b></u>	Impregnate with perfume or a sweet smelling substance. <i>Her hair was oiled and <b>perfumed</b>.</i>
<b>pudding</b>	A cooked sweet dish served after the main course of a meal. <i>A rice <b>pudding</b>.</i>



<b>redolent</b>	Serving to bring to mind. <i>A campaign <b>redolent</b> of machine politics.</i>
<b>saccharine</b>	Overly sweet. <i><b>Saccharine</b> music.</i>
<b>savor</b>	Taste appreciatively. <i><b>Savor</b> the soup.</i>
<b>savory</b>	Any of several aromatic herbs or subshrubs of the genus <i>Satureja</i> having spikes of flowers attractive to bees. <i>A past that was scarcely <b>savory</b>.</i>
<b>scent</b>	Catch the scent of get wind of. <i>The bull advanced <b>scenting</b> the breeze at every step.</i>
<b>smell</b>	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>Lingering kitchen <b>smells</b>.</i>
<b>sweet</b>	With sweetening added. <i>Hello my <b>sweet</b>.</i>
<b>taste</b>	Have a distinctive or characteristic taste. <i>The waiter poured some wine for him to <b>taste</b>.</i>
<b>tasty</b>	(of food) having a pleasant, distinct flavour. <i>A <b>tasty</b> young lady.</i>
<b>treacle</b>	Cloying sentimentality or flattery. <i>Enough of this <b>treacle</b> let s get back to business.</i>
<b>zesty</b>	Marked by spirited enjoyment.
