| <b>aboveground</b> | On or above the surface of the ground.<br><i><b>Aboveground</b> nuclear testing.</i>  |
| <b>absentee</b>    | One that is absent or not in residence.<br><i>An <b>absentee</b> from the match.</i>  |
| <b>absenteeism</b> | The practice of regularly staying away from work or school without good reason.<br><i>High levels of <b>absenteeism</b> caused by low job motivation.</i> |
| <b>away</b>        | Out of the way especially away from one's thoughts.<br><i><b>Away</b> fans chanted and cheered.</i>   |
| <b>besides</b>     | Making an additional point; anyway.<br><i>I'm capable of doing the work and a lot more <b>besides</b>.</i>  |
| <b>blubber</b>     | Excessive human fat.<br><i>My six pack is quickly being covered in <b>blubber</b>.</i>  |
| <b>breathe</b>     | Allow (a horse) to rest after exertion.<br><i>Plants <b>breathe</b> through all their organs including roots.</i>   |
| <b>by</b>          | So as to go past.<br><i>A car flashed <b>by</b> on the other side of the road.</i>  |
| <b>carnivore</b>   | Any animal that feeds on flesh.<br><i>Terrestrial <b>carnivores</b> have four or five clawed digits on each limb.</i>                                     |
| <b>carrion</b>     | The dead and rotting body of an animal; unfit for human food.<br><i>A crow wheeled over the hills in search of <b>carrion</b>.</i>                        |
| <b>chunk</b>       | Group or chunk together in a certain order or place side by side.<br><i><b>Chunk</b> a piece of wood on the fire will you.</i>                            |
| <b>clump</b>       | Form a clump or clumps.<br><i><b>Clumps</b> of earth.</i>   |
| <b>defeatist</b>   | Someone who is resigned to defeat without offering positive suggestions.<br><i>We have a duty not to be so <b>defeatist</b>.</i>                          |

| <b>doorway</b>  | An entrance to a room or building through a door.<br><i>He stuck his head in the <b>doorway</b>.</i>  |
| <b>emit</b>     | Express audibly; utter sounds (not necessarily words).<br><i>She <b>emitted</b> a sound like laughter.</i>  |
| <b>exclude</b>  | Deny (someone) access to a place, group, or privilege.<br><i>This policy <b>excludes</b> people who have a criminal record from entering the country.</i> |
| <b>exhale</b>   | Expel air.<br><i>He <b>exhaled</b> the smoke towards the ceiling.</i>   |
| <b>gone</b>     | Drained of energy or effectiveness; extremely tired; completely exhausted.<br><i>If we don't get there early all the best seats will be <b>gone</b>.</i>  |
| <b>hall</b>     | A large building for meetings or entertainment.<br><i>The village <b>hall</b>.</i>  |
| <b>home</b>     | Return home accurately from a long distance.<br><i>Montana is <b>home</b> to a surprising number of rare mammals.</i>                                     |
| <b>leave</b>    | Leave behind unintentionally.<br><i>She wants to <b>leave</b>.</i>  |
| <b>lump</b>     | (in taxonomy) classify plants or animals in relatively inclusive groups, disregarding minor variations.<br><i><b>Lump</b> labour.</i>                     |
| <b>offstage</b> | Situated or taking place in the area of a stage not visible to the audience.<br><i><b>Offstage</b> political meetings.</i>                                |
| <b>omit</b>     | Fail or neglect to do.<br><i>He was <b>omitted</b> from the second Test.</i>  |
| <b>orange</b>   | Orange color or pigment any of a range of colors between red and yellow.<br><i><b>Orange</b> juice.</i>   |
| <b>puff</b>     | A light inflated pastry or puff shell.<br><i>The critics <b>puffed</b> up this Broadway production.</i>   |
| <b>respire</b>  | Draw air into, and expel out of, the lungs.<br><i>Lichens <b>respire</b> at lower levels of temperature and moisture.</i>                                 |
| <b>steak</b>    | A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish.<br><i>A salmon <b>steak</b>.</i>   |
| <b>tent</b>     | Live or stay for a while in a tent.<br><i>Tim <b>tented</b> his fingers.</i>  |
| <b>uncooked</b> | Not cooked.<br><i>Frozen ready meals may be completely <b>uncooked</b>.</i>   |
