Associations of "Flesh out" (30 Words)

aboveground	On or above the surface of the ground. <i>Aboveground nuclear testing.</i>
absentee	One that is absent or not in residence. <i>An absentee from the match.</i>
<u>absenteeism</u>	The practice of regularly staying away from work or school without good reason. <i>High levels of absenteeism caused by low job motivation.</i>
<u>away</u>	Out of the way especially away from one's thoughts. <i>Away fans chanted and cheered.</i>
<u>besides</u>	Making an additional point; anyway. <i>I'm capable of doing the work and a lot more besides.</i>
<u>blubber</u>	Excessive human fat. <i>My six pack is quickly being covered in blubber.</i>
<u>breathe</u>	Allow (a horse) to rest after exertion. <i>Plants breathe through all their organs including roots.</i>
by	So as to go past. <i>A car flashed by on the other side of the road.</i>
carnivore	Any animal that feeds on flesh. <i>Terrestrial carnivores have four or five clawed digits on each limb.</i>
<u>carrion</u>	The dead and rotting body of an animal; unfit for human food. <i>A crow wheeled over the hills in search of carrion.</i>
<u>chunk</u>	Group or chunk together in a certain order or place side by side. <i>Chunk a piece of wood on the fire will you.</i>
clump	Form a clump or clumps. <i>Clumps of earth.</i>
defeatist	Someone who is resigned to defeat without offering positive suggestions. <i>We have a duty not to be so defeatist.</i>

doorway	An entrance to a room or building through a door. <i>He stuck his head in the doorway.</i>
emit	Express audibly; utter sounds (not necessarily words). <i>She emitted a sound like laughter.</i>
exclude	Deny (someone) access to a place, group, or privilege. <i>This policy excludes people who have a criminal record from entering the country.</i>
exhale	Expel air. <i>He exhaled the smoke towards the ceiling.</i>
gone	Drained of energy or effectiveness; extremely tired; completely exhausted. <i>If we don't get there early all the best seats will be gone.</i>
hall	A large building for meetings or entertainment. <i>The village hall.</i>
home	Return home accurately from a long distance. <i>Montana is home to a surprising number of rare mammals.</i>
leave	Leave behind unintentionally. <i>She wants to leave.</i>
lump	(in taxonomy) classify plants or animals in relatively inclusive groups, disregarding minor variations. <i>Lump labour.</i>
offstage	Situated or taking place in the area of a stage not visible to the audience. <i>Offstage political meetings.</i>
omit	Fail or neglect to do. <i>He was omitted from the second Test.</i>
orange	Orange color or pigment any of a range of colors between red and yellow. <i>Orange juice.</i>
puff	A light inflated pastry or puff shell. <i>The critics puffed up this Broadway production.</i>
respire	Draw air into, and expel out of, the lungs. <i>Lichens respire at lower levels of temperature and moisture.</i>
steak	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. <i>A salmon steak.</i>
tent	Live or stay for a while in a tent. <i>Tim tented his fingers.</i>
uncooked	Not cooked. <i>Frozen ready meals may be completely uncooked.</i>
