## Associations of "Flesh out" (30 Words)

<b>aboveground</b>	On or above the surface of the ground. <i><b>Aboveground</b> nuclear testing.</i>
<b>absentee</b>	One that is absent or not in residence. <i>An <b>absentee</b> from the match.</i>
<b><u>absenteeism</u></b>	The practice of regularly staying away from work or school without good reason. <i>High levels of <b>absenteeism</b> caused by low job motivation.</i>
<b><u>away</u></b>	Out of the way especially away from one's thoughts. <i><b>Away</b> fans chanted and cheered.</i>
<b><u>besides</u></b>	Making an additional point; anyway. <i>I'm capable of doing the work and a lot more <b>besides</b>.</i>
<b><u>blubber</u></b>	Excessive human fat. <i>My six pack is quickly being covered in <b>blubber</b>.</i>
<b><u>breathe</u></b>	Allow (a horse) to rest after exertion. <i>Plants <b>breathe</b> through all their organs including roots.</i>
<b>by</b>	So as to go past. <i>A car flashed <b>by</b> on the other side of the road.</i>
<b>carnivore</b>	Any animal that feeds on flesh. <i>Terrestrial <b>carnivores</b> have four or five clawed digits on each limb.</i>
<b><u>carrion</u></b>	The dead and rotting body of an animal; unfit for human food. <i>A crow wheeled over the hills in search of <b>carrion</b>.</i>
<b><u>chunk</u></b>	Group or chunk together in a certain order or place side by side. <i><b>Chunk</b> a piece of wood on the fire will you.</i>
<b>clump</b>	Form a clump or clumps. <i><b>Clumps</b> of earth.</i>
<b>defeatist</b>	Someone who is resigned to defeat without offering positive suggestions. <i>We have a duty not to be so <b>defeatist</b>.</i>

<b>doorway</b>	An entrance to a room or building through a door. <i>He stuck his head in the <b>doorway</b>.</i>
<b>emit</b>	Express audibly; utter sounds (not necessarily words). <i>She <b>emitted</b> a sound like laughter.</i>
<b>exclude</b>	Deny (someone) access to a place, group, or privilege. <i>This policy <b>excludes</b> people who have a criminal record from entering the country.</i>
<b>exhale</b>	Expel air. <i>He <b>exhaled</b> the smoke towards the ceiling.</i>
<b>gone</b>	Drained of energy or effectiveness; extremely tired; completely exhausted. <i>If we don't get there early all the best seats will be <b>gone</b>.</i>
<b>hall</b>	A large building for meetings or entertainment. <i>The village <b>hall</b>.</i>
<b>home</b>	Return home accurately from a long distance. <i>Montana is <b>home</b> to a surprising number of rare mammals.</i>
<b>leave</b>	Leave behind unintentionally. <i>She wants to <b>leave</b>.</i>
<b>lump</b>	(in taxonomy) classify plants or animals in relatively inclusive groups, disregarding minor variations. <i><b>Lump</b> labour.</i>
<b>offstage</b>	Situated or taking place in the area of a stage not visible to the audience. <i><b>Offstage</b> political meetings.</i>
<b>omit</b>	Fail or neglect to do. <i>He was <b>omitted</b> from the second Test.</i>
<b>orange</b>	Orange color or pigment any of a range of colors between red and yellow. <i><b>Orange</b> juice.</i>
<b>puff</b>	A light inflated pastry or puff shell. <i>The critics <b>puffed</b> up this Broadway production.</i>
<b>respire</b>	Draw air into, and expel out of, the lungs. <i>Lichens <b>respire</b> at lower levels of temperature and moisture.</i>
<b>steak</b>	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. <i>A salmon <b>steak</b>.</i>
<b>tent</b>	Live or stay for a while in a tent. <i>Tim <b>tented</b> his fingers.</i>
<b>uncooked</b>	Not cooked. <i>Frozen ready meals may be completely <b>uncooked</b>.</i>
