## Associations of "Floated" (30 Words)

<b>adrift</b>	Off course, wandering aimlessly. <i>The film industry was <b>adrift</b> in a sea of debt.</i>
<b><u>a</u>float</b>	Covered with water. <i>There are various rumours <b>a</b>float connected with his disappearance.</i>
<b><u>a</u>imless</b>	Aimlessly drifting. <i>An <b>a</b>imless existence.</i>
<b>boat</b>	Travel in a boat for pleasure. <i>They <b>boated</b> through fjords.</i>
<b><u>b</u>uoy</b>	Mark with a buoy. <i>The wreck is often <b>b</b>uoyed during summer months.</i>
<b>buoyancy</b>	The tendency to float in water or other liquid. <i>I admired his <b>buoyancy</b> and persistent good humor.</i>
<b>canoe</b>	Travel by canoe. <i>He had once <b>canoed</b> down the Nile.</i>
<b>capsize</b>	Cause (a boat) to overturn. <i>The craft <b>capsized</b> in heavy seas.</i>
<b>diving</b>	The sport or activity of diving into water from a diving board. <i>He scored with a <b>diving</b> header.</i>
<b><u>d</u>rift</b>	An act of driving cattle or sheep. <i>Caught the general <b>d</b>rift of the conversation.</i>
<b>floating</b>	Buoyant or suspended in water or air. <i><b>Floating</b> ribs are not connected with the sternum.</i>
<b>floe</b>	A sheet of floating ice.
<b><u>f</u>looded</b>	Covered with water. <i>A <b>flooded</b> bathroom.</i>
<b>flotsam</b>	The wreckage of a ship or its cargo found floating on or washed up by the sea. <i>The room was cleared of boxes and other <b>flotsam</b>.</i>

<b>hover</b>	Be undecided about something; waver between conflicting positions or courses of action. <i>Inflation will <b>hover</b> around the 4 per cent mark.</i>
<b>lifeboat</b>	A small boat kept on a ship for use in emergency, typically one of a number on deck or suspended from davits.
<b>loch</b>	A lake. <i><b>Loch</b> Lomond.</i>
<b>offshore</b>	Relating to the business of extracting oil or gas from the seabed. <i>Weather forecasters say the cyclone should move <b>offshore</b>.</i>
<b>pool</b>	Something resembling a pool of liquid. <i>A car <b>pool</b>.</i>
<b>raft</b>	Travel by raft in water. <i>I have <b>rafted</b> along the Rio Grande.</i>
<b>resurface</b>	(of a person) come out of hiding or obscurity. <i>The missing man suddenly <b>resurfaced</b> in New York.</i>
<b>river</b>	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea a lake or another river. <i>The <b>river</b> was navigable for 50 miles.</i>
<b>sea</b>	Used to refer to waves as opposed to calm sea. <i>Rocky bays lapped by vivid blue <b>sea</b>.</i>
<b>surf</b>	Ride a wave towards the shore on a surfboard. <i><b>Surf</b> the internet or the world wide web.</i>
<b>surfing</b>	The sport of riding a surfboard toward the shore on the crest of a wave. <i>Why share your internet connection with people <b>surfing</b> and chatting.</i>
<b>swim</b>	The act of swimming. <i>He landed two 5 lb chub from the same <b>swim</b>.</i>
<b>swimmer</b>	A sperm cell. <i>Red flags to warn <b>swimmers</b> of dangerous currents.</i>
<b>swimming</b>	The act of swimming. <i>A <b>swimming</b> instructor.</i>
<b>tarn</b>	A small mountain lake. <i>Malham <b>Tarn</b>.</i>
<b>wave</b>	Set waves in. <i>Gulls and cormorants bobbed on the <b>waves</b>.</i>
