Associations of "Floated" (30 Words)

adrift	Off course, wandering aimlessly. <i>The film industry was adrift in a sea of debt.</i>
<u>afloat</u>	Covered with water. <i>There are various rumours afloat connected with his disappearance.</i>
<u>aimless</u>	Aimlessly drifting. <i>An aimless existence.</i>
boat	Travel in a boat for pleasure. <i>They boated through fjords.</i>
<u>buoy</u>	Mark with a buoy. <i>The wreck is often buoyed during summer months.</i>
buoyancy	The tendency to float in water or other liquid. <i>I admired his buoyancy and persistent good humor.</i>
canoe	Travel by canoe. <i>He had once canoeed down the Nile.</i>
capsize	Cause (a boat) to overturn. <i>The craft capsized in heavy seas.</i>
diving	The sport or activity of diving into water from a diving board. <i>He scored with a diving header.</i>
<u>drift</u>	An act of driving cattle or sheep. <i>Caught the general drift of the conversation.</i>
floating	Buoyant or suspended in water or air. <i>Floating ribs are not connected with the sternum.</i>
floe	A sheet of floating ice.
<u>flooded</u>	Covered with water. <i>A flooded bathroom.</i>
flotsam	The wreckage of a ship or its cargo found floating on or washed up by the sea. <i>The room was cleared of boxes and other flotsam.</i>

hover	Be undecided about something; waver between conflicting positions or courses of action. <i>Inflation will hover around the 4 per cent mark.</i>
lifeboat	A small boat kept on a ship for use in emergency, typically one of a number on deck or suspended from davits.
loch	A lake. <i>Loch Lomond.</i>
offshore	Relating to the business of extracting oil or gas from the seabed. <i>Weather forecasters say the cyclone should move offshore.</i>
pool	Something resembling a pool of liquid. <i>A car pool.</i>
raft	Travel by raft in water. <i>I have rafted along the Rio Grande.</i>
resurface	(of a person) come out of hiding or obscurity. <i>The missing man suddenly resurfaced in New York.</i>
river	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea a lake or another river. <i>The river was navigable for 50 miles.</i>
sea	Used to refer to waves as opposed to calm sea. <i>Rocky bays lapped by vivid blue sea.</i>
surf	Ride a wave towards the shore on a surfboard. <i>Surf the internet or the world wide web.</i>
surfing	The sport of riding a surfboard toward the shore on the crest of a wave. <i>Why share your internet connection with people surfing and chatting.</i>
swim	The act of swimming. <i>He landed two 5 lb chub from the same swim.</i>
swimmer	A sperm cell. <i>Red flags to warn swimmers of dangerous currents.</i>
swimming	The act of swimming. <i>A swimming instructor.</i>
tarn	A small mountain lake. <i>Malham Tarn.</i>
wave	Set waves in. <i>Gulls and cormorants bobbed on the waves.</i>
