Fluidity as a Noun

Definitions of "Fluidity" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “fluidity” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Smooth elegance or grace.*
- *The state of being unsettled or unstable; changeability.*
- *The property of flowing easily.*
- *A changeable quality.*
- *The ability of a substance to flow easily.*

Synonyms of "Fluidity" as a noun (4 Words)

	The property of flowing easily.
fluidness	<i>A certain fluidness in his perception of time made him an unpredictable colleague.</i>
liquidity	The state in which a substance exhibits a characteristic readiness to flow with little or no tendency to disperse and relatively high incompressibility. <i>The banks closed causing serious liquidity problems for smaller companies.</i>
liquidness	The property of flowing easily.
runniness	The state or quality of being liquid in consistency. <i>Cook until no runniness remains.</i>

Usage Examples of "Fluidity" as a noun

- *Adding lead makes the alloy easier to cast because the melting point is reduced and the fluidity is increased.*
- *Demographers try to predict social fluidity.*
- *They believe that fluidity increases as the water gets warmer.*
- *A charming Oriental fluidity of manner.*
- *They moved with supreme skill and graceful fluidity.*
- *Lead especially assists in the fluidity of the molten metal.*
- *Tactical considerations can change rapidly given the fluidity of the situation.*
