Associations of "Fly off the handle" (30 Words)

abolish	Do away with. <i>Slavery was abolished in the mid 19th century in America and in Russia.</i>
abrogate	Repeal or do away with (a law, right, or formal agreement). <i>A proposal to abrogate temporarily the right to strike.</i>
abrogation	The act of abrogating; an official or legal cancellation.
annul	Declare (a marriage) to have had no legal existence. <i>The elections were annulled by the general amid renewed protests.</i>
ant	Social insect living in organized colonies; characteristically the males and fertile queen have wings during breeding season; wingless sterile females are the workers.
bee	An insect of a large group to which the honeybee belongs including many solitary as well as social kinds. <i>A sewing bee.</i>
<u>blimp</u>	A fat person. <i>I could work out four hours a day and still end up a blimp.</i>
bug	An insect of a large order distinguished by having mouthparts that are modified for piercing and sucking. <i>Is this hotel room bugged.</i>
butterfly	Flutter like a butterfly. <i>A social butterfly.</i>
<u>buzz</u>	Make a buzzing sound. <i>Planes buzzed the crowds in the square.</i>
<u>cancel</u>	A notation cancelling a previous sharp or flat. <i>Cancel the dinner party.</i>
cockroach	A scavenging insect that resembles a beetle, having long antennae and legs and typically a broad, flattened body. Several tropical kinds have become established worldwide as household pests.

dragonfly	Slender-bodied non-stinging insect having iridescent wings that are outspread at rest; adults and nymphs feed on mosquitoes etc.
exterminator	A person whose job is to eradicate pests from a building or area; a pest controller. <i>If your house has scorpions call a professional exterminator.</i>
flea	A small wingless jumping insect which feeds on the blood of mammals and birds. It sometimes transmits diseases through its bite, including plague and myxomatosis.
grasshopper	Terrestrial plant-eating insect with hind legs adapted for leaping.
housefly	A common small fly occurring worldwide in and around human habitation. Its eggs are laid in decaying material, and the fly can be a health hazard due to its contamination of food.
<u>hustle</u>	Engage in prostitution. <i>The hustle and bustle of the big cities.</i>
<u>insect</u>	Small air-breathing arthropod. <i>Insect pests.</i>
mosquito	A slender long-legged fly with aquatic larvae. The bite of the bloodsucking female can transmit a number of serious diseases including malaria and elephantiasis.
moth	A clothes moth. <i>I store my sweaters in plastic bags to protect them from moths.</i>
<u>null</u>	Combine a signal with another in order to create a null cancel out. <i>The establishment of a new interim government was declared null and void.</i>
<u>nullify</u>	Declare invalid. <i>Judges were unwilling to nullify government decisions.</i>
<u>override</u>	Counteract the normal operation of (an automatic gear shift in a vehicle). <i>Commission overrides give established carriers an unfair advantage.</i>
<u>pilot</u>	Be the pilot of an aircraft or ship. <i>A strike by local airline pilots.</i>
<u>plane</u>	Make even or smooth with or as with a carpenter's plane. <i>The plane of his forehead.</i>
rescind	Cancel officially. <i>The government eventually rescinded the directive.</i>
twitter	Talk in a light, high-pitched voice. <i>What a great crowd Perry twittered.</i>

warble

A lumpy abscess under the hide of domestic mammals caused by larvae of a botfly or warble fly.

*He **warbled** in an implausible soprano.*

withdrawal

A retraction of a previously held position.

*The **withdrawal** of French troops from Vietnam.*
