| <b>abolish</b>       | Do away with.<br><i>Slavery was <b>abolished</b> in the mid 19th century in America and in Russia.</i>   |
| <b>abrogate</b>      | Repeal or do away with (a law, right, or formal agreement).<br><i>A proposal to <b>abrogate</b> temporarily the right to strike.</i>   |
| <b>abrogation</b>    | The act of abrogating; an official or legal cancellation.  |
| <b>annul</b>         | Declare (a marriage) to have had no legal existence.<br><i>The elections were <b>annulled</b> by the general amid renewed protests.</i>  |
| <b>ant</b>           | Social insect living in organized colonies; characteristically the males and fertile queen have wings during breeding season; wingless sterile females are the workers.                        |
| <b>bee</b>           | An insect of a large group to which the honeybee belongs including many solitary as well as social kinds.<br><i>A sewing <b>bee</b>.</i>   |
| <b><u>blimp</u></b>  | A fat person.<br><i>I could work out four hours a day and still end up a <b>blimp</b>.</i>   |
| <b>bug</b>           | An insect of a large order distinguished by having mouthparts that are modified for piercing and sucking.<br><i>Is this hotel room <b>bugged</b>.</i>  |
| <b>butterfly</b>     | Flutter like a butterfly.<br><i>A social <b>butterfly</b>.</i>   |
| <b><u>buzz</u></b>   | Make a buzzing sound.<br><i>Planes <b>buzzed</b> the crowds in the square.</i>   |
| <b><u>cancel</u></b> | A notation cancelling a previous sharp or flat.<br><i><b>Cancel</b> the dinner party.</i>  |
| <b>cockroach</b>     | A scavenging insect that resembles a beetle, having long antennae and legs and typically a broad, flattened body. Several tropical kinds have become established worldwide as household pests. |

| <b>dragonfly</b>       | Slender-bodied non-stinging insect having iridescent wings that are outspread at rest; adults and nymphs feed on mosquitoes etc.  |
| <b>exterminator</b>    | A person whose job is to eradicate pests from a building or area; a pest controller.<br><i>If your house has scorpions call a professional <b>exterminator</b>.</i>                 |
| <b>flea</b>            | A small wingless jumping insect which feeds on the blood of mammals and birds. It sometimes transmits diseases through its bite, including plague and myxomatosis.                  |
| <b>grasshopper</b>     | Terrestrial plant-eating insect with hind legs adapted for leaping.   |
| <b>housefly</b>        | A common small fly occurring worldwide in and around human habitation. Its eggs are laid in decaying material, and the fly can be a health hazard due to its contamination of food. |
| <b><u>hustle</u></b>   | Engage in prostitution.<br><i>The <b>hustle</b> and bustle of the big cities.</i>   |
| <b><u>insect</u></b>   | Small air-breathing arthropod.<br><i><b>Insect</b> pests.</i>   |
| <b>mosquito</b>        | A slender long-legged fly with aquatic larvae. The bite of the bloodsucking female can transmit a number of serious diseases including malaria and elephantiasis.                   |
| <b>moth</b>            | A clothes moth.<br><i>I store my sweaters in plastic bags to protect them from <b>moths</b>.</i>  |
| <b><u>null</u></b>     | Combine a signal with another in order to create a null cancel out.<br><i>The establishment of a new interim government was declared <b>null</b> and void.</i>                      |
| <b><u>nullify</u></b>  | Declare invalid.<br><i>Judges were unwilling to <b>nullify</b> government decisions.</i>  |
| <b><u>override</u></b> | Counteract the normal operation of (an automatic gear shift in a vehicle).<br><i>Commission <b>overrides</b> give established carriers an unfair advantage.</i>                     |
| <b><u>pilot</u></b>    | Be the pilot of an aircraft or ship.<br><i>A strike by local airline <b>pilots</b>.</i>   |
| <b><u>plane</u></b>    | Make even or smooth with or as with a carpenter's plane.<br><i>The <b>plane</b> of his forehead.</i>  |
| <b>rescind</b>         | Cancel officially.<br><i>The government eventually <b>rescinded</b> the directive.</i>  |
| <b>twitter</b>         | Talk in a light, high-pitched voice.<br><i>What a great crowd Perry <b>twittered</b>.</i>   |

- warble** A lumpy abscess under the hide of domestic mammals caused by larvae of a botfly or warble fly.  
*He **warbled** in an implausible soprano.*
- withdrawal** A retraction of a previously held position.  
*The **withdrawal** of French troops from Vietnam.*
