I am focusing or, less commonly,
focussing

You are focusing or, less commonly,

He/She/It is focusing or, less commonly,
focussing

They are focusing or, less commonly,

Focus in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

I have focused or, less commonly, focussed

You have focused or, less commonly, focussed

He/She/It has focused or, less commonly, focussed

Focus in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had focused or, less commonly, We had focused or, less commonly,

Focus in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been focusing or, less commonly, focusing or, less commonly, focusing

You had been focusing or, less commonly, You had been focusing or, less

focussing commonly, focussing

He/She/It had been focusing or, less

They had been focusing or, less

commonly, focussing commonly, focussing



Focus in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will focus We will focus
You will focus You will focus
He/She/It will focus They will focus

Focus in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense
