academy	A school for special training. <i>A police academy.</i>
alumnus	A former member of a group, company, or organization. <i>A Royal Ballet alumnus.</i>
attendance	The action or state of going regularly to or being present at a place or event. <i>She is being blamed for the museum's low attendances.</i>
befriend	Become friends with. <i>He makes a point of befriending newcomers to Parliament.</i>
campus	The grounds of a school, hospital, or other institution. <i>For the first year I had a room on campus.</i>
classmate	An acquaintance that you go to school with.
diploma	A certificate awarded by an educational establishment to show that someone has successfully completed a course of study.
dorm	A dormitory.
dormitory	A university or college hall of residence or hostel. <i>A dormitory town.</i>
enrol	Enter (a deed or other document) among the rolls of a court of justice. <i>A campaign to enrol more foster carers.</i>
enrollment	The act of enrolling.
extracurricular	Characterized by adultery. <i>Extracurricular activities include sports music and gym clubs.</i>
freshman	A first-year student at high school. <i>Freshman year in high school or college.</i>
going	Progress affected by the condition of the ground. <i>People willing to work for the going rate.</i>
grad	One-hundredth of a right angle.

grader	A judge who assigns grades to something. <i>A first grader.</i>
homeroom	A classroom in which a group of students assembles daily with the same teacher before dispersing to other classes.
leave	Leave or give by will after one's death. <i>He leaves a wife and three children.</i>
matriculate	A person who has matriculated. <i>He was matriculated at Balliol College Oxford.</i>
pal	A friend. <i>We've been pals for a long time.</i>
playground	Yard consisting of an outdoor area for children's play. <i>Playground games.</i>
playpen	A portable enclosure in which babies may be left to play.
pupil	A learner who is enrolled in an educational institution. <i>They are former pupils of the school.</i>
school	The period of instruction in a school the time period when school is in session. <i>What will you do when you finish school.</i>
schoolmaster	Presiding officer of a school.
student	A person who takes an interest in a particular subject. <i>A group of student nurses.</i>
teach	A teacher. <i>She came to say Hi to her old teach.</i>
teacher	A person whose occupation is teaching. <i>A history teacher.</i>
trainee	Someone who is being trained. <i>Trainee solicitors.</i>
undergraduate	Denoting or relating to an undergraduate. <i>A group of Oxford undergraduates.</i>
