Associations of "For arbitrary" (30 Words)

arbitrarily	In a random manner. <i>Everyone has the right not to be arbitrarily detained.</i>
arrhythmic	Without regard for rhythm. <i>The arrhythmic phrasing of the music.</i>
assigned	Appointed to a post or duty. <i>Assigned duties.</i>
careless	Not giving sufficient attention or thought to avoiding harm or errors. <i>A careless housekeeper.</i>
cursory	Hasty and therefore not thorough or detailed. <i>A cursory glance at the figures.</i>
discretionary	(especially of funds) not earmarked; available for use as needed. <i>Discretionary portfolios.</i>
haphazard	Lacking any obvious principle of organization. <i>A most haphazard system of record keeping.</i>
haphazardly	In a random manner. <i>The film feels haphazardly thrown together.</i>
hasty	Done with very great haste and without due deliberation. <i>A hasty attempt to defuse the situation.</i>
headlong	Excessively quick. <i>A headlong rush to sell.</i>
hurried	Moving rapidly or performed quickly or in great haste. <i>A hurried trip to the store.</i>
impetuosity	Rash impulsiveness.
impetuous	Characterized by undue haste and lack of thought or deliberation. <i>An impetuous display of spending and gambling.</i>
impulsive	Proceeding from natural feeling or impulse without external stimulus. <i>An impulsive force.</i>

indiscriminate	Done at random or without careful judgement. <i>Indiscriminate reading habits.</i>
<u>indiscriminately</u>	In a random manner; unsystematically. <i>His armies slaughtered men women and children indiscriminately.</i>
madcap	Amusingly eccentric. <i>A madcap scheme.</i>
perfunctorily	In a set manner without serious attention. <i>He kissed her cheek perfunctorily.</i>
precipitant	A substance that causes the precipitation of a specified substance. <i>A protein precipitant.</i>
random	An unknown, unspecified, or odd person. <i>I just sat down by myself and talked to some randoms.</i>
randomize	Make (a set of items, people, etc.) unpredictable, unsystematic, or random in order or arrangement. <i>You can randomize the ingredients with the tap of a button.</i>
randomly	Without method or conscious decision; indiscriminately. <i>Troops fired randomly from tanks.</i>
rashly	Without careful consideration of the possible consequences; impetuously. <i>He rashly promised crime would fall sharply by September.</i>
rushed	Done or completed too hurriedly; hasty. <i>I m too rushed to do it.</i>
slapdash	Hurriedly and carelessly. <i>Slapdash work.</i>
slipshod	Characterized by a lack of care, thought, or organization. <i>Slipshod spelling.</i>
spasmodic	Occurring in spells and often abruptly. <i>His body made a spasmodic jerk.</i>
<u>swift</u>	A swift flying insectivorous bird with long slender wings and a superficial resemblance to a swallow spending most of its life on the wing. <i>Swift flight of an arrow.</i>
<u>unjustified</u>	Lacking justification or authorization. <i>Unjustified price increases.</i>
<u>unpredictable</u>	Not occurring at a regular rate or fixed intervals. <i>An unpredictable or indeterminable future.</i>
