Done with very great haste and without due deliberation. hasty

A **hasty** attempt to defuse the situation.

Excessively quick. headlong

A **headlong** rush to sell.

Moving rapidly or performed quickly or in great haste. hurried

A **hurried** trip to the store.

impetuosity Rash impulsiveness.

Characterized by undue haste and lack of thought or deliberation. <u>impetuous</u>

An **impetuous** display of spending and gambling.

Proceeding from natural feeling or impulse without external stimulus. impulsive

An **impulsive** force.



indiscriminate Done at random or without careful judgement.

**Indiscriminate** reading habits.

indiscriminately In a random manner; unsystematically.

His armies slaughtered men women and children **indiscriminately**.

madcap Amusingly eccentric. A madcap scheme.

**perfunctorily** In a set manner without serious attention.

He kissed her cheek **perfunctorily**.

**precipitant**A substance that causes the precipitation of a specified substance.

A protein **precipitant**.

random

An unknown, unspecified, or odd person.

Livet set down by myself and talked to some random

I just sat down by myself and talked to some **random**s.

Make (a set of items, people, etc.) unpredictable, unsystematic, or

randomize random in order or arrangement.

You can **randomize** the ingredients with the tap of a button.

randomly Without method or conscious decision; indiscriminately.

Troops fired randomly from tanks.

Without careful consideration of the possible consequences;

rashly impetuously.

He **rashly** promised crime would fall sharply by September.

rushed Done or completed too hurriedly; hasty.

I m too **rushed** to do it.

slapdash Hurriedly and carelessly.

**Slapdash** work.

**slipshod** Characterized by a lack of care, thought, or organization.

**Slipshod** spelling.

spasmodic

Occurring in spells and often abruptly.

His body made a **spasmodic** jerk.

A swift flying insectivorous bird with long slender wings and a

superficial resemblance to a swallow spending most of its life on the

swift wing.

**Swift** flight of an arrow.

unjustified Lacking justification or authorization.

**Unjustified** price increases.

unpredictable

Not occurring at a regular rate or fixed intervals.

An **unpredictable** or indeterminable future.
