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Associations of "For assassin" (30 Words)

accused	A defendant in a criminal proceeding. <i>The accused was ordered to stand trial on a number of charges.</i>
assassinate	Murder (an important person) for political or religious reasons. <i>He assassinated his enemy's character.</i>
assassination	An attack intended to ruin someone's reputation. <i>A failed assassination attempt.</i>
assault	The crime of forcing a person to submit to sexual intercourse against his or her will. <i>Thunder assaulted the ears.</i>
attempted	Tried unsuccessfully. <i>Attempted murder.</i>
chartered	(of a city, company, university, or other body) founded or having its rights and privileges established by means of a charter. <i>A chartered plane.</i>
collusion	Collusion between ostensible opponents in a lawsuit. <i>The armed forces were working in collusion with drug traffickers.</i>
conscienceless	Lacking a conscience. <i>Brash unprincipled and conscienceless.</i>
conspirator	A member of a conspiracy. <i>Conspirators had planned to seize the state.</i>
convict	A person who has been convicted of a criminal offense. <i>Two escaped convicts kidnapped them at gunpoint.</i>
culpable	Deserving blame. <i>Culpable negligence.</i>
dispatch	A report sent in from abroad by a journalist. <i>The government dispatched 150 police to restore order.</i>

employed	Having your services engaged for; or having a job especially one that pays wages or a salary. <i>Up to 40 per cent of employed people are in part time jobs.</i>
genocide	The deliberate killing of a large number of people from a particular nation or ethnic group with the aim of destroying that nation or group. <i>News of genocides went unreported.</i>
hired	Hired for the exclusive temporary use of a group of travelers. <i>A hired gun.</i>
homicide	A murderer. <i>Knives account for a third of all homicides.</i>
<u>killer</u>	An animal that has been selected for slaughter. <i>I woke up with a killer hangover.</i>
killing	The act of terminating a life. <i>Years of killing and destruction.</i>
massacre	Kill a large number of people indiscriminately. <i>Thousands were brutally massacred by soldiers.</i>
<u>murderer</u>	A person who commits murder. <i>Convicted murderers.</i>
psychopathic	Suffering from or constituting a chronic mental disorder with abnormal or violent social behaviour. <i>An obsessive attention to detail that looked almost psychopathic.</i>
regicide	Someone who commits regicide the killer of a king.
<u>slaughter</u>	Kill (animals) for food. <i>The slaughter of 20 peaceful demonstrators.</i>
<u>slay</u>	Kill (a person or animal) in a violent way. <i>You slay me you really do.</i>
slayer	Someone who kills a person or animal in a violent way. <i>David the slayer of Goliath.</i>
suicide	A person who commits suicide. <i>We shot free throws and if we missed we ran suicides.</i>
<u>unconscionable</u>	Not right or reasonable. <i>An unconscionable liar.</i>
wanted	Desired or wished for or sought. <i>So good to feel wanted.</i>
