<u>accent</u>	Put stress on utter with an accent. A strong American <b>accent</b> .
<u>accentuate</u>	Put stress on; utter with an accent. <i>His jacket unfortunately</i> <b>accentuate</b> d his paunch.
<u>arrogant</u>	Having or showing feelings of unwarranted importance out of overbearing pride. <i>A typically <b>arrogant</b> assumption.</i>
autocratic	Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power. ${\it Autocratic}\ behavior.$
brash	Having an ostentatious or tasteless appearance. He was <b>brash</b> cocky and arrogant.
categorical	Unambiguously explicit and direct. A <b>categorical</b> denial.
cavalier	Given to haughty disregard of others. Anne was irritated by his <b>cavalier</b> attitude.
confident	Not liable to error in judgment or action. A <b>confident</b> speaker.
despotic	Of or typical of a despot; tyrannical. A <b>despotic</b> regime.
dictatorial	Having or showing an autocratic manner. A <b>dictatorial</b> regime.
domineering	Asserting one's will over another in an arrogant way. <i>How can I do my job with a <b>domineering</b> boss yelling in my ear.</i>
emphasis	Vigour or intensity of expression. Inflection and <b>emphasis</b> can change the meaning of what is said.
emphasized	Spoken with emphasis.



<u>emphatic</u>	An emphatic consonant. The children were <b>emphatic</b> that they would like to repeat the experience.
emphatically	In a forceful way. Greg is <b>emphatically</b> not a slacker.
forceful	Forceful and definite in expression or action. She was a <b>forceful</b> personality.
<u>fortified</u>	Secured with bastions or fortifications. <i>Fortified</i> wine.
<u>haughty</u>	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i>A look of haughty disdain.</i>
headstrong	Energetically wilful and determined. The <b>headstrong</b> impulsiveness of youth.
highlight	Create highlights in hair. I ve had my hair <b>highlight</b> ed regularly for the last ten years.
<u>imperative</u>	A verb or phrase in the imperative mood. <i>Free movement of labour was an economic</i> <b>imperative</b> .
imperious	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. His <b>imperious</b> demands.
<u>oppressive</u>	Weighing heavily on the senses or spirit. <i>Oppressive</i> sorrows.
<u>overbearing</u>	Unpleasantly overpowering. An <b>overbearing</b> ill tempered brute.
peremptory	Insisting on immediate attention or obedience, especially in a brusquely imperious way. A swaggering <b>peremptory</b> manner.
stressed	Strengthened by the application of stress during manufacture prestressed. <b>Stressed</b> workers reported smoking more.
strong	Having a strong physiological or chemical effect. A <b>strong</b> smell.
strongly	In a very intense or distinctive manner. He was <b>strongly</b> affected by the divorce of his parents.
supercilious	Behaving or looking as though one thinks one is superior to others. <i>His mother eyed my clothes with a <b>supercilious</b> air.</i>
<u>tyrannical</u>	Characteristic of tyranny; oppressive and controlling. A <b>tyrannical</b> government.
