emphasis Vigour or intensity of expression.

Inflection and **emphasis** can change the meaning of what is said.

**emphasized** Spoken with emphasis.



emphatic An emphatic consonant.

The children were **emphatic** that they would like to repeat the experience.

emphatically In a forceful way.

Greg is **emphatically** not a slacker.

**forceful** Forceful and definite in expression or action.

She was a **forceful** personality.

**fortified** Secured with bastions or fortifications.

**Fortified** wine.

Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as

**haughty** unworthy.

A look of **haughty** disdain.

**headstrong** Energetically wilful and determined.

The **headstrong** impulsiveness of youth.

highlight Create highlights in hair.

I ve had my hair **highlight**ed regularly for the last ten years.

**Imperative** A verb or phrase in the imperative mood.

Free movement of labour was an economic **imperative**.

oppressive Oppressive sorrows.

Unpleasantly overpowering.

An overbearing ill tempered brute.

Insisting on immediate attention or obedience, especially in a brusquely

**peremptory** imperious way.

A swaggering **peremptory** manner.

**stressed** Strengthened by the application of stress during manufacture prestressed.

**Stressed** workers reported smoking more.

Having a strong physiological or chemical effect.

strong A strong smell.

strongly In a very intense or distinctive manner.

He was **strongly** affected by the divorce of his parents.

**supercitious** Behaving or looking as though one thinks one is superior to others.

His mother eyed my clothes with a **supercilious** air.
