Associations of "For assertive" (30 Words)

accent	Put stress on utter with an accent. <i>A strong American accent.</i>
accentuate	Put stress on; utter with an accent. <i>His jacket unfortunately accentuated his paunch.</i>
arrogant	Having or showing feelings of unwarranted importance out of overbearing pride. <i>A typically arrogant assumption.</i>
autocratic	Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power. <i>Autocratic behavior.</i>
brash	Having an ostentatious or tasteless appearance. <i>He was brash cocky and arrogant.</i>
categorical	Unambiguously explicit and direct. <i>A categorical denial.</i>
cavalier	Given to haughty disregard of others. <i>Anne was irritated by his cavalier attitude.</i>
confident	Not liable to error in judgment or action. <i>A confident speaker.</i>
despotic	Of or typical of a despot; tyrannical. <i>A despotic regime.</i>
dictatorial	Having or showing an autocratic manner. <i>A dictatorial regime.</i>
domineering	Asserting one's will over another in an arrogant way. <i>How can I do my job with a domineering boss yelling in my ear.</i>
emphasis	Vigour or intensity of expression. <i>Inflection and emphasis can change the meaning of what is said.</i>
emphasized	Spoken with emphasis.

<u>emphatic</u>	An emphatic consonant. <i>The children were emphatic that they would like to repeat the experience.</i>
<u>emphatically</u>	In a forceful way. <i>Greg is emphatically not a slacker.</i>
forceful	Forceful and definite in expression or action. <i>She was a forceful personality.</i>
<u>fortified</u>	Secured with bastions or fortifications. <i>Fortified wine.</i>
<u>haughty</u>	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i>A look of haughty disdain.</i>
headstrong	Energetically wilful and determined. <i>The headstrong impulsiveness of youth.</i>
highlight	Create highlights in hair. <i>I've had my hair highlighted regularly for the last ten years.</i>
<u>imperative</u>	A verb or phrase in the imperative mood. <i>Free movement of labour was an economic imperative.</i>
imperious	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i>His imperious demands.</i>
<u>oppressive</u>	Weighing heavily on the senses or spirit. <i>Oppressive sorrows.</i>
<u>overbearing</u>	Unpleasantly overpowering. <i>An overbearing ill tempered brute.</i>
peremptory	Insisting on immediate attention or obedience, especially in a brusquely imperious way. <i>A swaggering peremptory manner.</i>
stressed	Strengthened by the application of stress during manufacture prestressed. <i>Stressed workers reported smoking more.</i>
strong	Having a strong physiological or chemical effect. <i>A strong smell.</i>
strongly	In a very intense or distinctive manner. <i>He was strongly affected by the divorce of his parents.</i>
supercilious	Behaving or looking as though one thinks one is superior to others. <i>His mother eyed my clothes with a supercilious air.</i>
<u>tyrannical</u>	Characteristic of tyranny; oppressive and controlling. <i>A tyrannical government.</i>
