abbess	A woman who is the head of an abbey of nuns.
abbey	A church that was formerly an abbey.
abbot	A man who is the head of an abbey of monks.
archdeacon	(Anglican Church) an ecclesiastical dignitary usually ranking just below a bishop.
augustinian	A Roman Catholic friar or monk belonging to one of the Augustinian monastic orders.
bishop	A chess piece typically with its top shaped like a mitre that can move in any direction along a diagonal on which it stands Each player starts the game with two bishops one moving on white squares and the other on black.
buddhism	A religion represented by the many groups (especially in Asia) that profess various forms of the Buddhist doctrine and that venerate Buddha.
buddhist	Of or relating to or supporting Buddhism.
canon	A rule or especially body of rules or principles generally established as valid and fundamental in a field of art or philosophy. <i>Canons of polite society.</i>
<u>cathedral</u>	The principal Christian church building of a bishop's diocese. St Paul's Cathedral .
catholic	Free from provincial prejudices or attachments. <i>Her tastes are pretty catholic.</i>
<u>christian</u>	Relating to or characteristic of Christianity.
cloister	Surround with a cloister. She cloister ed herself in the office.
<u>congregation</u>	A group of people assembled for religious worship. Large congregation s of birds may cause public harm.



defrock	Divest of the frock; of church officials. The Supreme Court found him in contempt of the tribunal and defrock ed him as an appeals court judge.
<u>gothic</u>	Of or relating to the Goths. Gothic novels like Frankenstein.
holy	(of a person) devoted to the service of God. Saints and holy men.
minster	Any of certain cathedrals and large churches; originally connected to a monastery. <i>York Minster</i> .
monastery	The residence of a religious community.
monastic	A monk or other follower of a monastic rule. She set her things round the monastic student bedroom.
monk	A male religious living in a cloister and devoting himself to contemplation and prayer and work.
pagoda	An ornamental imitation of a Hindu or Buddhist pagoda.
pastor	Be pastor of a church or congregation. He continued to study law while pastor ing in Chelsea.
<u>priest</u>	Ordain to the priesthood. The plays were performed within the sacred area of Dionysus in the presence of his priest .
priory	Religious residence in a monastery governed by a prior or a convent governed by a prioress.
rector	(in the Roman Catholic Church) a priest in charge of a church or of a religious institution.
religion	A particular system of faith and worship. The world s great religion s.
saint	Declare a dead person to be a saint. The sandy shores of the River Nid where Holy Olaf s bones were laid to rest before he had been saint ed.
<u>shrine</u>	Enshrine. A Hindu shrine at which offerings are placed twice a day.
temple	A thing regarded as holy or likened to a temple especially a person s body. <i>The veins in his temple throbbed</i> .
