Associations of "For city" (30 Words)

autonomous	(of a country or region) having the freedom to govern itself or control its own affairs. <i>The federation included sixteen autonomous republics.</i>
borough	A town or district which is an administrative unit.
capital	(of a letter of the alphabet) large in size and of the form used to begin sentences and names. <i>Our capital concern was to avoid defeat.</i>
community	Joint ownership or liability. <i>Community health services.</i>
constituency	A group of people with shared interests or political opinions. <i>Most politicians are more interested in the voice of their constituency.</i>
county	A sporting team playing for a county. <i>The county plans to build a new road.</i>
depopulate	Substantially reduce the population of (an area). <i>The epidemic depopulated the countryside.</i>
district	Regulate housing in; of certain areas of towns. <i>A district health authority.</i>
domestic	Converted or adapted to domestic use. <i>They are often called to sort out a domestic.</i>
downtown	The downtown area of a town or city. <i>A downtown bar.</i>
enfranchise	Grant voting rights. <i>Slaves were enfranchised in the mid 19th century.</i>
local	A local branch of an organization especially a trade union. <i>Local anesthesia.</i>
locality	A surrounding or nearby region. <i>She had few friends in the locality.</i>

metropolitan	Relating to or denoting a metropolitan or his see. A metropolitan bishop.
municipal	Of or relating to the government of a municipality. <i>International law only authorizes a belligerent to punish a spy under its municipal law.</i>
municipality	The governing body of a municipality. <i>Voters in each municipality choose between four candidates.</i>
<u>neighborhood</u>	People living near one another. <i>My neighborhood voted for Bush.</i>
populous	Densely populated. <i>The populous city of Shanghai.</i>
prefecture	A prefect's office or tenure. <i>Enraged fans besieged the Prefecture of Police.</i>
<u>province</u>	Northern Ireland. <i>I made my way home to the dreary provinces by train.</i>
<u>provincial</u>	Characteristic of the provinces or their people. Provincial towns.
quarter	Cut a log into quarters and these into planks so as to show the grain well. <i>He surrendered but asked for quarter.</i>
<u>slum</u>	Spend time at a lower socio-economic level than one's own, motivated by curiosity or desire for adventure; usage considered condescending and insensitive. Slum dwellers.
sophisticate	Make someone or something more sophisticated. <i>He is still the butt of jokes made by New York sophisticates.</i>
subdivide	Divide (something that has already been divided or that is a separate unit). <i>The cells subdivided.</i>
suburban	Contemptibly dull and ordinary. Suburban life.
<u>town</u>	The particular town under consideration especially one's own town. <i>A rift between the city's town and gown.</i>
urban	Relating to or concerned with a city or densely populated area. Urban manners.
<u>village</u>	A self-contained district or community within a town or city regarded as having features characteristic of village life. <i>Pretty fishing villages.</i>

The grooves in the bit of a key that correspond to the wards in a lock.
*I saw them keeping **ward** at one of those huge gates.*
