<b>apoplectic</b>	Relating to or denoting apoplexy (stroke). <i>Mark was <b>apoplectic</b> with rage at the decision.</i>
<b>apoplexy</b>	Extreme anger. <i>The decision has aroused <b>apoplexy</b> among environmentalists.</i>
<b>ascension</b>	A movement upward. <i>His <b>ascension</b> to the presidency.</i>
<b>autopsy</b>	Perform an autopsy on a dead body do a post mortem. <i>On <b>autopsy</b> it was established that he had suffered from a rare brain condition.</i>
<b>bier</b>	A coffin along with its stand. <i>We followed the <b>bier</b> to the graveyard.</i>
<b>dead</b>	Devoid of living things. <i>Crater Lake is in the crater of a <b>dead</b> volcano of the Cascade Range.</i>
<b>death</b>	The personification of death. <i>I don t believe in life after <b>death</b>.</i>
<b>decease</b>	Pass from physical life and lose all bodily attributes and functions necessary to sustain life. <i>He held the post until his untimely <b>decease</b> in 1991.</i>
<b>deceased</b>	Someone who is no longer alive. <i>He is <b>deceased</b>.</i>
<b>defunct</b>	No longer existing or functioning. <i>A <b>defunct</b> Indian tribe.</i>
<b>disappear</b>	Get lost, as without warning or explanation. <i>He <b>disappeared</b> without a trace.</i>
<b>doom</b>	Make certain of the failure or destruction of. <i>The aircraft was sent crashing to its <b>doom</b> in the water.</i>

<b>expire</b>	(of a person) die. <i>The volume of <b>expired</b> air.</i>
<b>extinct</b>	No longer in existence; lost or especially having died out leaving no living representatives. <i>We might one day resurrect <b>extinct</b> species.</i>
<b>funeral</b>	A sermon delivered at a funeral. <i>In the afternoon he d attended a <b>funeral</b>.</i>
<b>gone</b>	No longer available; consumed or used up. <i>The food s all <b>gone</b> I m afraid.</i>
<b>holocaust</b>	Destruction or slaughter on a mass scale, especially caused by fire or nuclear war. <i>A nuclear <b>holocaust</b>.</i>
<b>inelastic</b>	(of a collision) involving an overall loss of translational kinetic energy. <i>A tough <b>inelastic</b> membrane.</i>
<b>intestacy</b>	The situation of being or dying without a legally valid will.
<b>intestate</b>	Not having made a will before one dies. <i>He died <b>intestate</b>.</i>
<b>moribund</b>	Not growing or changing; without force or vitality. <i>The <b>moribund</b> commercial property market.</i>
<b>mortality</b>	The state of being subject to death. <i>Post operative <b>mortality</b> was 90 per cent for some operations.</i>
<b>mortuary</b>	A room or building in which dead bodies are kept, for hygienic storage or for examination, until burial or cremation. <i>A <b>mortuary</b> temple.</i>
<b>perish</b>	(of rubber, food, etc.) lose its normal qualities; rot or decay. <i>I was <b>perished</b> with cold before the end of the day.</i>
<b>rip</b>	A fraud or swindle a rip off. <i>Fire <b>ripped</b> through her bungalow.</i>
<b>sepulchral</b>	Of or relating to a sepulchre. <i><b>Sepulchral</b> monuments.</i>
<b>slayer</b>	Someone who causes the death of a person or animal. <i>A dragon <b>slayer</b>.</i>
<b>testate</b>	A person who makes a will. <i>He desired to die <b>testate</b>.</i>
<b>tombstone</b>	Jump into the sea from a cliff or other high point. <i>Thrill seeking lads <b>tombstoned</b> off the rocks.</i>
