To cause inconvenience or discomfort to. inconvenience

An uncomfortable feeling of mental painfulness or distress. irritation

The minor **irritation**s of life.

itching An irritating cutaneous sensation that produces a desire to scratch.

Dissatisfied and complaining or rebellious.

malcontent The **malcontent** generals saw their role as leaders of this counter

revolution.

A feeling of sickness with an inclination to vomit. nausea

The stories will launch a wave of public **nausea** and outrage.

A bothersome annoying person. nuisance

Act in disregard of laws, rules, contracts, or promises. offend

A feeling of anger caused by being offended. umbrage

Not acceptable; not welcome. unacceptable
