find	Make a discovery make a new finding. <i>Find someone guilty.</i>
fixate	Direct one’s eyes towards. <i>Her eyes fixated on a point on the horizon.</i>
look	Of a building or room have an outlook in a specified direction. <i>I look at tennis differently from some coaches.</i>

loom	Weave on a loom. <i>Another air plane loomed into the sky.</i>
observing	Quick to notice; showing quick and keen perception.
peek	A quick or furtive look. <i>I only peeked I didn't see anything interesting.</i>
peep	A quick or furtive look. <i>The sun began to peep out.</i>
phantasm	A ghostly appearing figure. <i>Every phantasm of a hope was quickly nullified.</i>
predominate	Be the strongest or main element; be greater in number or amount. <i>Private interest was not allowed to predominate over the public good.</i>
see	Go to see for professional or business reasons. <i>I went to see my friend Mary the other day.</i>
seem	Seem to be true probable or apparent. <i>I seem to be misunderstood by everyone.</i>
show	Show in or as in a picture. <i>Showing a large dog is not always easy.</i>
smug	Having or showing an excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements. <i>He was feeling smug after his win.</i>
superficial	Appearing to be true or real only until examined more closely. <i>The resemblance between the breeds is superficial.</i>
surface	Put a coat on cover the surface of furnish with a surface. <i>The earth's surface.</i>
testify	Provide evidence for. <i>The bleak lines testify to inner torment.</i>
visit	The act of visiting in an official capacity as for an inspection. <i>He shall visit earth in mercy.</i>
visual	Visible. <i>Visual perception.</i>
visually	With respect to vision. <i>A visually stunning film.</i>
witness	Be a witness to. <i>The memorial service was witness to the wide circle of his interests.</i>
