## Associations of "For empathetic" (30 Words)

<b>altruism</b>	The quality of unselfish concern for the welfare of others. <i>Reciprocal <b>altruism</b>.</i>
<b>benefaction</b>	An act intending or showing kindness and good will. <i>An exceptional <b>benefaction</b>.</i>
<a href="#">benevolence</a>	An inclination to do kind or charitable acts.
<b>caring</b>	The work or practice of looking after those unable to care for themselves, especially on account of age or illness. <i><b>Caring</b> friends.</i>
<b>compassionate</b>	Showing or having compassion. <i>I allowed him to go home on <b>compassionate</b> grounds.</i>
<b>condolence</b>	An expression of sympathy with another’s grief. <i>They sent their <b>condolences</b>.</i>
<b>considerateness</b>	Kind and considerate regard for others.
<b>empathize</b>	Understand and share the feelings of another. <i>Counsellors need to be able to <b>empathize</b> with people.</i>
<b>empathy</b>	Understanding and entering into another’s feelings.
<a href="#">forgiving</a>	Inclined or able to forgive and show mercy. <i>A kindly <b>forgiving</b> nature.</i>
<a href="#">generosity</a>	Acting generously. <i>I was overwhelmed by the <b>generosity</b> of friends and neighbours.</i>
<b>goodwill</b>	The friendly hope that something will succeed. <i>A <b>goodwill</b> gesture.</i>
<b>kindness</b>	A kind act. <i>It would be a <b>kindness</b> on your part to invite her.</i>
<b>loving</b>	Enjoying the specified activity or thing. <i><b>Loving</b> glances.</i>

<b>mawkish</b>	Sentimental in an exaggerated or false way. <i>The <b>mawkish</b> smell of warm beer.</i>
<b>melodrama</b>	Behaviour or events that resemble melodrama. <i>What little is known of his early life is cloaked in <b>melodrama</b>.</i>
<b>merciful</b>	(of an event) coming as a mercy; bringing someone relief from something unpleasant. <i>A <b>merciful</b> god.</i>
<b>pathetic</b>	Relating to the emotions. <i>He s a <b>pathetic</b> excuse for a man.</i>
<b>pathos</b>	A feeling of sympathy and sorrow for the misfortunes of others. <i>The film captured all the <b>pathos</b> of their situation.</i>
<b>pity</b>	Share the suffering of. <i>It s a <b>pity</b> he couldn t do it.</i>
<b>regretful</b>	Feeling or expressing regret or sorrow or a sense of loss over something done or undone. <i>He sounded <b>regretful</b> but pointed out that he had committed himself.</i>
<b>regrettable</b>	(of conduct or an event) giving rise to regret; undesirable; unwelcome. <i>The loss of this number of jobs is <b>regrettable</b>.</i>
<b>ruth</b>	A book of the Old Testament that tells the story of Ruth who was not an Israelite but who married an Israelite and who stayed with her mother-in-law Naomi after her husband died.
<b>sadness</b>	The quality of excessive mournfulness and uncheerfulness. <i>A source of great <b>sadness</b>.</i>
<b>selflessness</b>	The quality of unselfish concern for the welfare of others. <i>A noble act of <b>selflessness</b>.</i>
<b>sentimentality</b>	Exaggerated and self-indulgent tenderness, sadness, or nostalgia. <i>There are passages which verge on <b>sentimentality</b>.</i>
<b>sympathetic</b>	Evoking empathic or sympathetic feelings. <i>Hubbell is a more <b>sympathetic</b> character.</i>
<b>sympathy</b>	Sharing the feelings of others (especially feelings of sorrow or anguish). <i>The magnetic field oscillates in <b>sympathy</b>.</i>
<b>telepathy</b>	Apparent communication from one mind to another without using sensory perceptions.
<b>understanding</b>	Characterized by understanding based on comprehension and discernment and empathy. <i>A kind and <b>understanding</b> man.</i>
