## Associations of "For figure out" (30 Words)

<b>algebra</b>	A system of algebra based on given axioms. <i>Courses in <b>algebra</b> geometry and Newtonian physics.</i>
<a href="#">architect</a>	A person who is qualified to design buildings and to plan and supervise their construction. <i>The <b>architects</b> of the reform programme.</i>
<b>by</b>	In reserve; not for immediate use. <i>He let only a moment go <b>by</b>.</i>
<a href="#">camp</a>	A group of people living together in a camp. <i>City kids get to see the country at a summer <b>camp</b>.</i>
<a href="#">carve</a>	Make (a turn) by tilting one's skis on to their edges and using one's weight to bend them so that they slide in an arc. <i><b>Carve</b> one's name into the bark.</i>
<b>ceramic</b>	The material from which ceramics are made. <i>Many of the painted <b>ceramics</b> are of native manufacture.</i>
<a href="#">characterization</a>	The creation or construction of a fictional character. <i>He preferred to emphasize <b>characterization</b> and human conflict.</i>
<b>cinematic</b>	Relating to the cinema. <i><b>Cinematic</b> output.</i>
<a href="#">count</a>	Take into account include. <i>He hopes his sporting attitude will <b>count</b> in his favour.</i>
<b>delineation</b>	The action of indicating the exact position of a border or boundary. <i>The eventual <b>delineation</b> of the border between the two states.</i>
<a href="#">depiction</a>	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>Michelangelo's <b>depictions</b> of the male nude.</i>
<b>gargoyle</b>	A grotesque carved human or animal face or figure projecting from the gutter of a building, typically acting as a spout to carry water clear of a wall.

<b>memorialize</b>	Be or provide a memorial to a person or an event. <i>The President <b>memorialized</b> the heroes of the battle.</i>
<b><u>monument</u></b>	An enduring and memorable example of something. <i>A <b>monument</b> to Magellan is in the main square of the city.</i>
<b>nominal</b>	Of, relating to, or characteristic of an amount that is not adjusted for inflation. <i>A <b>nominal</b> group.</i>
<b>oblique</b>	An oblique muscle. <i>Acute and obtuse angles are <b>oblique</b> angles.</i>
<b>painter</b>	An artist who paints. <i>A self employed <b>painter</b> and decorator.</i>
<b>photography</b>	The art or practice of taking and processing photographs.
<b>picture</b>	Represent in a photograph or picture. <i>We were warned not to take <b>pictures</b>.</i>
<b><u>portrait</u></b>	Denoting a format of printed matter which is higher than it is wide. <i>A <b>portrait</b> of George III.</i>
<b>portraiture</b>	Vivid and detailed description. <i>His strength as a novelist lay in his <b>portraiture</b> of upper class families.</i>
<b>portrayal</b>	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>His <b>portrayal</b> of the title character.</i>
<b>sculpt</b>	Create by shaping stone or wood or any other hard material. <i>She was teaching him how to <b>sculpt</b>.</i>
<b>sculptor</b>	An artist who makes sculptures.
<b><u>sculpture</u></b>	A work of art made by sculpture. <i>The boundary between painting and <b>sculpture</b> is displaced.</i>
<b>statuary</b>	Statues regarded collectively. <i>Classical <b>statuary</b>.</i>
<b><u>statue</u></b>	A carved or cast figure of a person or animal, especially one that is life-size or larger.
<b>statuesque</b>	Of size and dignity suggestive of a statue. <i>Her <b>statuesque</b> beauty.</i>
<b>vandalism</b>	Willful wanton and malicious destruction of the property of others. <i>Surveillance of the building would reduce <b>vandalism</b> and theft.</i>
<b>woodwork</b>	Work made of wood; especially moldings or stairways or furniture. <i>He taught <b>woodwork</b> at night school.</i>
