algebra	A system of algebra based on given axioms. <i>Courses in algebra geometry and Newtonian physics.</i>
<u>architect</u>	A person who is qualified to design buildings and to plan and supervise their construction. <i>The architects of the reform programme.</i>
by	In reserve; not for immediate use. <i>He let only a moment go by.</i>
<u>camp</u>	A group of people living together in a camp. <i>City kids get to see the country at a summer camp.</i>
<u>carve</u>	Make (a turn) by tilting one's skis on to their edges and using one's weight to bend them so that they slide in an arc. <i>Carve one's name into the bark.</i>
ceramic	The material from which ceramics are made. <i>Many of the painted ceramics are of native manufacture.</i>
<u>characterization</u>	The creation or construction of a fictional character. <i>He preferred to emphasize characterization and human conflict.</i>
cinematic	Relating to the cinema. <i>Cinematic output.</i>
<u>count</u>	Take into account include. <i>He hopes his sporting attitude will count in his favour.</i>
delineation	The action of indicating the exact position of a border or boundary. <i>The eventual delineation of the border between the two states.</i>
<u>depiction</u>	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>Michelangelo's depictions of the male nude.</i>
gargoyle	A grotesque carved human or animal face or figure projecting from the gutter of a building, typically acting as a spout to carry water clear of a wall.

memorialize	Be or provide a memorial to a person or an event. <i>The President memorialized the heroes of the battle.</i>
<u>monument</u>	An enduring and memorable example of something. <i>A monument to Magellan is in the main square of the city.</i>
nominal	Of, relating to, or characteristic of an amount that is not adjusted for inflation. <i>A nominal group.</i>
oblique	An oblique muscle. <i>Acute and obtuse angles are oblique angles.</i>
painter	An artist who paints. <i>A self employed painter and decorator.</i>
photography	The art or practice of taking and processing photographs.
picture	Represent in a photograph or picture. <i>We were warned not to take pictures.</i>
<u>portrait</u>	Denoting a format of printed matter which is higher than it is wide. <i>A portrait of George III.</i>
portraiture	Vivid and detailed description. <i>His strength as a novelist lay in his portraiture of upper class families.</i>
portrayal	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>His portrayal of the title character.</i>
sculpt	Create by shaping stone or wood or any other hard material. <i>She was teaching him how to sculpt.</i>
sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures.
<u>sculpture</u>	A work of art made by sculpture. <i>The boundary between painting and sculpture is displaced.</i>
statuary	Statues regarded collectively. <i>Classical statuary.</i>
<u>statue</u>	A carved or cast figure of a person or animal, especially one that is life-size or larger.
statuesque	Of size and dignity suggestive of a statue. <i>Her statuesque beauty.</i>
vandalism	Willful wanton and malicious destruction of the property of others. <i>Surveillance of the building would reduce vandalism and theft.</i>
woodwork	Work made of wood; especially moldings or stairways or furniture. <i>He taught woodwork at night school.</i>
