| agape | (of a person’s mouth) wide open in surprise or wonder. <i>Downes listened mouth agape with incredulity.</i> |
| ambidextrous | Able to use the right and left hands equally well. <i>Few of us are naturally ambidextrous.</i> |
| androgynous | Partly male and partly female in appearance; of indeterminate sex. <i>He used surgery and cosmetics to make his face look pasty and bizarrely androgynous.</i> |
| asexual | (of a person) having no sexual feelings or desires, or not sexually attracted to anyone. <i>Each polyp is capable of budding new polyps though asexual reproduction in spring.</i> |
| bisexual | (of a species) having two distinct sexes. <i>In fungi unisexual reproduction has been observed in several species that can also undergo traditional bisexual reproduction.</i> |
| buoyant | Cheerful and optimistic. <i>Buoyant balloons.</i> |
| dating | Use of chemical analysis to estimate the age of geological specimens. |
| discrimination | Recognition and understanding of the difference between one thing and another. <i>Victims of racial discrimination.</i> |
| eros | (Greek mythology) god of love; son of Aphrodite; identified with Roman Cupid. |
| heterosexual | A heterosexual person someone having a sexual orientation to persons of the opposite sex. <i>Heterosexual relationships.</i> |
| homosexual | Someone who practices homosexuality having a sexual attraction to persons of the same sex. <i>Homosexual desire.</i> |

| <u>inequality</u> | The relation between two expressions that are not equal, employing a sign such as \neq 'not equal to', $>$ 'greater than', or $<$ 'less than'. <i>Social inequality.</i> |
| male | Of a fitting or part of machinery manufactured to fit inside a corresponding female part. <i>The male population.</i> |
| neuter | The neuter gender. <i>The Spirit is a neuter word in Greek.</i> |
| obscenity | The trait of behaving in an obscene manner. <i>The book was banned for obscenity.</i> |
| patriarchy | A system of society or government in which the father or eldest male is head of the family and descent is reckoned through the male line. <i>We live in a patriarchy.</i> |
| prejudiced | Having or showing a dislike or distrust that is derived from prejudice; bigoted. <i>People are prejudiced against us.</i> |
| prostitution | The practice or occupation of engaging in sexual activity with someone for payment. <i>The sale of captives into slavery and prostitution.</i> |
| prurient | Characterized by lust. <i>Prurient literature.</i> |
| racial | Relating to the major groupings into which humankind is sometimes divided on the basis of physical characteristics or shared ancestry. <i>A racial minority.</i> |
| reproductive | Producing new life or offspring. <i>The female reproductive system.</i> |
| segregation | The action or state of setting someone or something apart from others. <i>An official policy of racial segregation.</i> |
| sexism | Discriminatory or abusive behavior towards members of the opposite sex. <i>Sexism in language is an offensive reminder of the way the culture sees women.</i> |
| <u>sexist</u> | A person with sexist views. <i>Sexists have no place in our modern political campaigns.</i> |
| subculture | A social group within a national culture that has distinctive patterns of behavior and beliefs. <i>In what ways does the social environment predispose certain individuals to join delinquent subcultures.</i> |

A vulgar remark or act.
