## Associations of "For good measure" (30 Words)

<b>airspeed</b>	The speed of an aircraft relative to the air in which it is flying.
<b>ammeter</b>	A meter that measures the flow of electrical current in amperes.
<b>appraise</b>	Assess the performance of (an employee) formally. <i>They <b>appraised</b> the painting at 200 000.</i>
<b>assess</b>	Charge (a person or a property) with a payment, such as a tax or a fine. <i>The damage was <b>assessed</b> at 5 billion.</i>
<b>calculate</b>	Suppose or believe. <i>I was bright enough to <b>calculate</b> that she had been on vacation.</i>
<b>calibrate</b>	Mark (a gauge or instrument) with a standard scale of readings. <i>The depth gauge is <b>calibrated</b> in centimetres.</i>
<b>count</b>	The total determined by counting. <i>At the last <b>count</b> fifteen applications were still outstanding.</i>
<b>estimate</b>	Judge tentatively or form an estimate of quantities or time. <i>He got an <b>estimate</b> from the car repair shop.</i>
<b>evaluate</b>	Evaluate or estimate the nature quality ability extent or significance of. <i>How do you <b>evaluate</b> this grant proposal.</i>
<b>fathomable</b>	(of depth) capable of being sounded or measured for depth.
<b>gage</b>	Offer (an object or one’s life) as a guarantee of good faith. <i>A guide sent to them by the headman of this place <b>gaged</b> his life as a forfeit if he failed.</i>
<b>gauge</b>	Measure the dimensions of an object with a gauge. <i>She was unable to <b>gauge</b> his mood.</i>
<b>measurable</b>	Of distinguished importance. <i>A <b>measurable</b> figure in literature.</i>
<b>measurement</b>	A unit or system of measuring. <i>His inside leg <b>measurement</b>.</i>

<b>meter</b>	Stamp with a meter indicating the postage. <i><b>Meter</b> the flow of water.</i>
<b>metric</b>	The metric system. <i><b>Metrical</b> equivalents.</i>
<b>pricing</b>	The evaluation of something in terms of its price.
<b>quantifiable</b>	Capable of being quantified. <i><b>Quantifiable</b> data.</i>
<b>satisfactory</b>	(of a patient in a hospital) not deteriorating or likely to die. <i><b>Satisfactory</b> living conditions.</i>
<b>sensitiveness</b>	Sensitivity to emotional feelings (of self and others). <i>The <b>sensitiveness</b> of Mimosa leaves does not depend on a change of growth.</i>
<b>speedometer</b>	An instrument on a vehicle's dashboard indicating its speed.
<b>surveying</b>	The work of examining and reporting on the general condition of a building, especially for a prospective buyer. <i>Modern <b>surveying</b> equipment.</i>
<b>tachometer</b>	Measuring instrument for indicating speed of rotation.
<b>tantamount</b>	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were <b>tantamount</b> to an admission of guilt.</i>
<b>thermometer</b>	Measuring instrument for measuring temperature.
<b>touchstone</b>	A standard or criterion by which something is judged or recognized. <i>They tend to regard grammar as the <b>touchstone</b> of all language performance.</i>
<b>velocity</b>	Distance travelled per unit time. <i>The tank shot backwards at an incredible <b>velocity</b>.</i>
<b>voltmeter</b>	An instrument for measuring electric potential in volts.
<b>weathercock</b>	(of a boat or aircraft) tend to turn to head into the wind. <i>He sometimes has a problem with the boat <b>weathercocking</b> before she can gather way on a new tack.</i>
<b>yardstick</b>	A ruler or tape that is three feet long. <i>On what kind of <b>yardstick</b> is he basing his judgment.</i>
