Associations of "For good measure" (30 Words)

airspeed	The speed of an aircraft relative to the air in which it is flying.
ammeter	A meter that measures the flow of electrical current in amperes.
appraise	Assess the performance of (an employee) formally. <i>They appraised the painting at 200 000.</i>
<u>assess</u>	Charge (a person or a property) with a payment, such as a tax or a fine. <i>The damage was assessed at 5 billion.</i>
<u>calculate</u>	Suppose or believe. <i>I was bright enough to calculate that she had been on vacation.</i>
<u>calibrate</u>	Mark (a gauge or instrument) with a standard scale of readings. <i>The depth gauge is calibrated in centimetres.</i>
<u>count</u>	The total determined by counting. <i>At the last count fifteen applications were still outstanding.</i>
estimate	Judge tentatively or form an estimate of quantities or time. <i>He got an estimate from the car repair shop.</i>
evaluate	Evaluate or estimate the nature quality ability extent or significance of. <i>How do you evaluate this grant proposal.</i>
fathomable	(of depth) capable of being sounded or measured for depth.
gage	Offer (an object or one’s life) as a guarantee of good faith. <i>A guide sent to them by the headman of this place gaged his life as a forfeit if he failed.</i>
<u>gauge</u>	Measure the dimensions of an object with a gauge. <i>She was unable to gauge his mood.</i>
measurable	Of distinguished importance. <i>A measurable figure in literature.</i>
measurement	A unit or system of measuring. <i>His inside leg measurement.</i>

meter	Stamp with a meter indicating the postage. <i>Meter the flow of water.</i>
metric	The metric system. <i>Metrical equivalents.</i>
pricing	The evaluation of something in terms of its price.
quantifiable	Capable of being quantified. <i>Quantifiable data.</i>
satisfactory	(of a patient in a hospital) not deteriorating or likely to die. <i>Satisfactory living conditions.</i>
sensitiveness	Sensitivity to emotional feelings (of self and others). <i>The sensitiveness of Mimosa leaves does not depend on a change of growth.</i>
speedometer	An instrument on a vehicle's dashboard indicating its speed.
surveying	The work of examining and reporting on the general condition of a building, especially for a prospective buyer. <i>Modern surveying equipment.</i>
tachometer	Measuring instrument for indicating speed of rotation.
tantamount	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were tantamount to an admission of guilt.</i>
thermometer	Measuring instrument for measuring temperature.
touchstone	A standard or criterion by which something is judged or recognized. <i>They tend to regard grammar as the touchstone of all language performance.</i>
velocity	Distance travelled per unit time. <i>The tank shot backwards at an incredible velocity.</i>
voltmeter	An instrument for measuring electric potential in volts.
weathercock	(of a boat or aircraft) tend to turn to head into the wind. <i>He sometimes has a problem with the boat weathercocking before she can gather way on a new tack.</i>
yardstick	A ruler or tape that is three feet long. <i>On what kind of yardstick is he basing his judgment.</i>
