| abrade | Wear away. <i>It was a landscape slowly abraded by a fine stinging dust.</i> |
| <u>abrasive</u> | Showing little concern for the feelings of others; harsh. <i>Don t use abrasive kitchen cleaners.</i> |
| awl | A pointed tool for marking surfaces or for punching small holes. |
| ax | Chop or split with an ax. <i>Axe wood.</i> |
| behead | Cut the head of. <i>Mary was beheaded at Fotheringhay.</i> |
| <u>brace</u> | Support or hold steady and make steadfast with or as if with a brace. <i>Brace your elbows while working on the potter s wheel.</i> |
| chop | Form or shape by chopping. <i>We started our run into a two foot chop.</i> |
| <u>craft</u> | An aircraft or spaceship. <i>He crafted the chair lovingly.</i> |
| crush | The act of crushing. <i>He crushed the paper in his hands.</i> |
| drudgery | Hard monotonous routine work. <i>Domestic drudgery.</i> |
| finely | In tiny pieces. <i>We are trying to judge answers too finely.</i> |
| flour | Convert grain into flour. <i>Flour fish or meat before frying it.</i> |
| grind | Press or grind with a crushing noise. <i>The slow grind of the US legal system.</i> |
| grindstone | A revolving stone shaped like a disk; used to grind or sharpen or polish edge tools. |

| hammer | Hit or beat something repeatedly with a hammer or similar object. <i>Maclean was presented with a great chance but he hammered the ball over the bar from 10 yards.</i> |
| heighten | Increase the height of. <i>Pot smokers claim it heightens their awareness.</i> |
| knife | Use a knife on. <i>A shard of steel knifed through the mainsail.</i> |
| mash | Crush or smash something to a pulp. <i>The worst thing you can do is mash the brake pedal.</i> |
| mill | Grind something in a mill. <i>Ordinary wool blankets are made by milling a woven wool fabric.</i> |
| millstone | Each of two circular stones used for grinding grain. |
| pointed | Having a point. <i>Pointed comments were made about racial discrimination within the army.</i> |
| powder | A cosmetic in the form of powder applied to a person's face with a brush or soft pad. <i>She powdered her face and put on a dab of perfume.</i> |
| pulverize | Become powder or dust. <i>He had a winning car and pulverized the opposition.</i> |
| sharp | Ending in a sharp point. <i>Fresh goats milk cheese has a slightly sharper flavour than fromage frais.</i> |
| sharpen | Improve or cause to improve. <i>Sharpen the knives.</i> |
| shatter | Break or cause to break suddenly and violently into pieces. <i>The wine glass shattered.</i> |
| shred | Tear into shreds. <i>Executives have shredded key documents.</i> |
| squash | Edible fruit of a squash plant eaten as a vegetable. <i>A poetry squash in London.</i> |
| tamp | A tool for tamping e.g. for tamping tobacco into a pipe bowl or a charge into a drill hole etc. <i>When the hole was tamped to the top gunpowder was inserted.</i> |
| whet | Sharpen by rubbing as on a whetstone. <i>He swallowed his two dozen oysters as a whet.</i> |
