Associations of "For ignite" (30 Words)

blast	Create by using explosives. <i>It could turn out to be a real blast.</i>
blaze	Indicate by marking trees with blazes. <i>The horse had a blaze between its eyes.</i>
burn	A mark left on something as a result of being burned. <i>The iron burnt a hole in my dress.</i>
cinder	Waste matter produced by smelting or refining ore; slag. <i>A cold hearth full of cinders.</i>
combust	Cause to burn or combust. <i>Riots combusted Pakistan after the U S air attacks on Afghanistan.</i>
combustible	A combustible substance. <i>A volatile and combustible personality.</i>
combustion	A process in which a substance reacts with oxygen to give heat and light. <i>Combustion grew until revolt was unavoidable.</i>
erupt	Erupt or intensify suddenly. <i>Vesuvius erupts once in a while.</i>
explosive	Likely to cause an outburst of anger or controversy. <i>Explosive force.</i>
fire	Start or maintain a fire in. <i>The engine fired and she pushed her foot down on the accelerator.</i>
firework	A device with an explosive that burns at a low rate and with colored flames; can be used to illuminate areas or send signals etc. <i>When you put these men together you re bound to get fireworks.</i>
flame	Shine or glow like a flame. <i>Send out an unsolicited email and you could possibly receive thousands of flames.</i>

flammable	Easily ignited. <i>The use of highly flammable materials.</i>
flare	Become flared and widen usually at one end. <i>She flared up shouting at Geoffrey.</i>
furor	A sudden outburst (as of protest).
incendiary	An incendiary bomb or device. <i>Incendiary rhetoric.</i>
incinerate	Cause to undergo combustion. <i>Waste packaging is to be incinerated rather than buried in landfills.</i>
incinerator	An apparatus for burning waste material, especially industrial waste, at high temperatures until it is reduced to ash.
inflame	Become inflamed get sore. <i>High fines further inflamed public feelings.</i>
kindle	Catch fire. <i>The setting sun kindled the sky with oranges and reds.</i>
lava	Rock that in its molten form as magma issues from volcanos lava is what magma is called when it reaches the surface. <i>Porphyritic lavas.</i>
pyrotechnic	Suggestive of fireworks. <i>A pyrotechnic display.</i>
scald	Any of a number of plant diseases which produce an effect similar to that of scalding especially a disease of fruit marked by browning and caused by excessive sunlight bad storage conditions or atmospheric pollution. <i>There s bowls to scald and bairns to fetch.</i>
smolder	Burn slowly and without a flame. <i>A smoldering fire.</i>
smoulder	Smoke coming from a smouldering fire. <i>The bonfire still smouldered the smoke drifting over the paddock.</i>
spark	Emit or produce sparks. <i>There was a spark of light.</i>
tan	Get a tan from wind or sun. <i>The sun had already tanned his face golden.</i>
tinder	Material for starting a fire. <i>They slashed down the undergrowth for tinder.</i>
torch	Tall stalked very woolly mullein with densely packed yellow flowers ancient Greeks and Romans dipped the stalks in tallow for funeral torches. <i>The madman torched the barns.</i>
