<a href="#">certain</a>	Certain to occur destined or inevitable Benjamin Franklin. <i>It s <b>certain</b> that more changes are in the offing.</i>
<b>constitutive</b>	Having the power to establish or give organized existence to something. <i>Poverty is a <b>constitutive</b> element of a particular form of economic growth.</i>
<b>crucial</b>	Having crucial relevance. <i><b>Crucial</b> information.</i>
<b>essential</b>	A thing that is absolutely necessary. <i>Funds <b>essential</b> to the completion of the project.</i>
<b>important</b>	Important in effect or meaning. <i>The speech had passion and more <b>important</b> compassion.</i>
<b>importantly</b>	Used to emphasize a significant point. <i>Kruger strutted forward <b>importantly</b>.</i>
<b>indispensability</b>	The quality possessed by something that you cannot possibly do without.
<a href="#">indispensable</a>	Not to be dispensed with; essential. <i>He made himself <b>indispensable</b> to the parish priest.</i>
<b>ineluctable</b>	Impossible to avoid or evade. <i>An <b>ineluctable</b> destiny.</i>
<a href="#">inevitably</a>	By necessity. <i><b>Inevitably</b> some details are already out of date.</i>
<a href="#">insurmountable</a>	Too great to be overcome. <i>An <b>insurmountable</b> problem.</i>
<a href="#">integral</a>	The result of a mathematical integration $F x$ is the integral of $f x$ if $dF dx = f x$ . <i>The unit comes complete with <b>integral</b> pump and heater.</i>
<b>meaningful</b>	Having a meaning or purpose. <i><b>Meaningful</b> elements in a language.</i>

<b><u>must</u></b>	Used in ironic questions expressing irritation. <i>This video is a <b>must</b> for everyone.</i>
<b><u>necessarily</u></b>	In an essential manner. <i>It is <b>necessarily</b> so.</i>
<b>necessary</b>	(of a concept, statement, etc.) inevitably resulting from the nature of things, so that the contrary is impossible. <i>The <b>necessary</b> consequences of one's actions.</i>
<b>necessity</b>	The state of being unavoidable. <i>The <b>necessity</b> of providing parental guidance.</i>
<b>need</b>	Have or feel a need for. <i>Lest you even more than <b>needs</b> embitter our parting.</i>
<b>needs</b>	In such a manner as could not be otherwise. <i>We must <b>needs</b> by objective.</i>
<b><u>originally</u></b>	From or in the beginning; at first. <i>The suggestions so <b>originally</b> and persuasively outlined.</i>
<b>perforce</b>	By necessity; by force of circumstance. <i>Amateurs <b>perforce</b> have to settle for less expensive solutions.</i>
<b><u>prerequisite</u></b>	Something that is required in advance. <i>The student must have the <b>prerequisite</b> skills.</i>
<b>required</b>	Required by rule. <i>Eight editions were published each <b>required</b> reading for trainees.</i>
<b>requisite</b>	Anything indispensable. <i>She believed privacy to be a <b>requisite</b> for a peaceful life.</i>
<b><u>staple</u></b>	A piece of thin wire with two short right angled end pieces which are driven by a stapler through sheets of paper to fasten them together. <i>Merrill <b>stapled</b> a batch of papers together.</i>
<b><u>substantial</u></b>	Of or relating to the real nature or essential elements of something. <i>The wind was violent and felt <b>substantial</b> enough to lean against.</i>
<b><u>unavoidable</u></b>	Impossible to avoid or evade. <i>An <b>unavoidable</b> accident.</i>
<b><u>unconditional</u></b>	Not subject to any conditions. <i><b>Unconditional</b> surrender.</i>
<b><u>underlying</u></b>	Lying or situated under something. <i><b>Underlying</b> problems need to be addressed.</i>
<b><u>vital</u></b>	Absolutely necessary; essential. <i><b>Vital</b> for a healthy society.</i>
