<u>abject</u>	Of the most contemptible kind. <i>An abject apology.</i>
calibre	The quality of someone’s character or the level of their ability. <i>Educational facilities of a very high calibre.</i>
<u>deficient</u>	Insufficient or inadequate. <i>The documentary evidence is deficient.</i>
<u>disadvantaged</u>	Marked by deprivation especially of the necessities of life or healthful environmental influences. <i>Disadvantaged groups such as the unemployed.</i>
hapless	Deserving or inciting pity. <i>A hapless victim.</i>
<u>inadequate</u>	Lacking the quality or quantity required; insufficient for a purpose. <i>A sad solitary inadequate man.</i>
inauspicious	Not auspicious; boding ill. <i>This is the inauspicious star of disaster.</i>
<u>indigent</u>	Poor; needy. <i>A charity for the relief of indigent artists.</i>
lacking	Inadequate in amount or degree. <i>Adequate resources are sadly lacking.</i>
<u>meager</u>	Deficient in amount or quality or extent. <i>Meager resources.</i>
meagerly	Deficient in amount or quality or extent. <i>These voices are meagerly represented at the conference.</i>
measly	Ridiculously small or few. <i>Three measly votes.</i>
minus	A disadvantage. <i>Minus or negative factors.</i>

<u>miserable</u>	Miserly. <i>Their happiness made Anne feel even more miserable.</i>
<u>needy</u>	Needy people collectively. <i>The provision of humanitarian assistance to the needy.</i>
paltry	Not worth considering. <i>Naval glory struck him as paltry.</i>
<u>pathetic</u>	Deserving or inciting pity- Galsworthy. <i>She looked so pathetic that I bent down to comfort her.</i>
pauper	A poor person who may bring a legal action without payment of costs. <i>He died a pauper.</i>
piteous	Deserving or inciting pity- Galsworthy. <i>A piteous cry.</i>
pitiable	Deserving or inciting pity- Galsworthy. <i>The men were in a pitiable condition.</i>
<u>pitiful</u>	Compassionate. <i>A pitiful attempt to impress her.</i>
scanty	(of clothing) revealing the body. <i>The women looked cold in their scanty bodices.</i>
<u>scarce</u>	Scarcely. <i>Fresh vegetables were scarce during the drought.</i>
substandard	Falling short of some prescribed norm. <i>Substandard spellings.</i>
undermanned	Inadequate in number of workers or assistants etc.
undersized	Of less than the usual size. <i>The undersized cubs may not survive the winter.</i>
<u>unfortunate</u>	A person who suffers bad fortune. <i>An unfortunate decision.</i>
unlucky	Marked by or promising bad fortune- W.H.Prescott. <i>The visitors were unlucky to have a goal disallowed.</i>
wanting	Not existing; absent. <i>Mandibles are wanting in many of these insects.</i>
wretched	Characterized by physical misery. <i>She disliked the wretched man intensely.</i>
