abiding	Lasting a long time. An abiding belief.
<u>ceaseless</u>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The ceaseless thunder of surf.</i>
changeless	Not subject or susceptible to change or variation in form or quality or nature. <i>Changeless</i> truths.
confirmed	(of a person) firmly established in a particular habit, belief, or way of life and unlikely to change their ways. Confirmed reservations.
constant	Occurring continuously over a period of time. A man constant in adherence to his ideals.
<u>continually</u>	Seemingly without interruption. I was continually moving around.
continuing	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. The continuing struggle to put food on the table.
continuous	Forming a series with no exceptions or reversals. A continuous line has no gaps or breaks in it.
<u>durable</u>	Very long lasting. Durable denim jeans.
endless	(of a belt, chain, or tape) having the ends joined to form a loop allowing continuous action. <i>Endless</i> waves.
<u>enduring</u>	Lasting a long time. He formed a number of enduring relationships with women.
equable	Not easily disturbed or angered; calm and even-tempered. An equable temper.



eternity	Used euphemistically to refer to death. A silence that lasted an eternity .
everlasting	Any of various plants of various genera of the family Compositae having flowers that can be dried without loss of form or color. Life everlasting .
immutable	Unchanging over time or unable to be changed. The immutable laws of nature.
incessant	(of something regarded as unpleasant) continuing without pause or interruption. The incessant beat of the music.
incessantly	With unflagging resolve. She talked about him incessantly .
indelible	(of ink or a pen) making marks that cannot be removed. <i>The story made an indelible impression on me.</i>
indestructible	Very long lasting. Indestructible plastic containers.
ineradicable	Not able to be destroyed or rooted out. <i>Ineradicable hostility</i> .
invariable	(of a quantity) constant. An invariable temperature.
permanence	The state or quality of lasting or remaining unchanged indefinitely. The clarity and permanence of the dyes.
permanency	The property of being able to exist for an indefinite duration.
<u>permanent</u>	Lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely. <i>Permanent</i> address.
perpetual	Never ending or changing. A perpetual secretary of the society.
<u>stable</u>	Shelter in a stable. A stable peace.
unceasing	Not coming to an end; continuous. The unceasing efforts of the staff.
<u>unchangeable</u>	Not changeable or subject to change-Ashley Montagu. The unchangeable seasons.
<u>unchanging</u>	Conforming to the same principles or course of action over time. The party stood for unchanging principles.
<u>unremitting</u>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Unremitting drizzle</i> .
