Associations of "For lasting" (30 Words)

abiding	Lasting a long time. <i>An abiding belief.</i>
<u>ceaseless</u>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The ceaseless thunder of surf.</i>
changeless	Not subject or susceptible to change or variation in form or quality or nature. <i>Changeless truths.</i>
confirmed	(of a person) firmly established in a particular habit, belief, or way of life and unlikely to change their ways. <i>Confirmed reservations.</i>
constant	Occurring continuously over a period of time. <i>A man constant in adherence to his ideals.</i>
<u>continually</u>	Seemingly without interruption. <i>I was continually moving around.</i>
continuing	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. <i>The continuing struggle to put food on the table.</i>
continuous	Forming a series with no exceptions or reversals. <i>A continuous line has no gaps or breaks in it.</i>
<u>durable</u>	Very long lasting. <i>Durable denim jeans.</i>
endless	(of a belt, chain, or tape) having the ends joined to form a loop allowing continuous action. <i>Endless waves.</i>
<u>enduring</u>	Lasting a long time. <i>He formed a number of enduring relationships with women.</i>
equable	Not easily disturbed or angered; calm and even-tempered. <i>An equable temper.</i>

eternity	Used euphemistically to refer to death. <i>A silence that lasted an eternity.</i>
everlasting	Any of various plants of various genera of the family Compositae having flowers that can be dried without loss of form or color. <i>Life everlasting.</i>
immutable	Unchanging over time or unable to be changed. <i>The immutable laws of nature.</i>
incessant	(of something regarded as unpleasant) continuing without pause or interruption. <i>The incessant beat of the music.</i>
incessantly	With unflagging resolve. <i>She talked about him incessantly.</i>
indelible	(of ink or a pen) making marks that cannot be removed. <i>The story made an indelible impression on me.</i>
indestructible	Very long lasting. <i>Indestructible plastic containers.</i>
ineradicable	Not able to be destroyed or rooted out. <i>Ineradicable hostility.</i>
invariable	(of a quantity) constant. <i>An invariable temperature.</i>
permanence	The state or quality of lasting or remaining unchanged indefinitely. <i>The clarity and permanence of the dyes.</i>
permanency	The property of being able to exist for an indefinite duration.
permanent	Lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely. <i>Permanent address.</i>
perpetual	Never ending or changing. <i>A perpetual secretary of the society.</i>
stable	Shelter in a stable. <i>A stable peace.</i>
unceasing	Not coming to an end; continuous. <i>The unceasing efforts of the staff.</i>
unchangeable	Not changeable or subject to change-Ashley Montagu. <i>The unchangeable seasons.</i>
unchanging	Conforming to the same principles or course of action over time. <i>The party stood for unchanging principles.</i>
unremitting	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Unremitting drizzle.</i>
