## Associations of "For lasting" (30 Words)

<b>abiding</b>	Lasting a long time. <i>An <b>abiding</b> belief.</i>
<b><u>ceaseless</u></b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The <b>ceaseless</b> thunder of surf.</i>
<b>changeless</b>	Not subject or susceptible to change or variation in form or quality or nature. <i><b>Changeless</b> truths.</i>
<b>confirmed</b>	(of a person) firmly established in a particular habit, belief, or way of life and unlikely to change their ways. <i><b>Confirmed</b> reservations.</i>
<b>constant</b>	Occurring continuously over a period of time. <i>A man <b>constant</b> in adherence to his ideals.</i>
<b><u>continually</u></b>	Seemingly without interruption. <i>I was <b>continually</b> moving around.</i>
<b>continuing</b>	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. <i>The <b>continuing</b> struggle to put food on the table.</i>
<b>continuous</b>	Forming a series with no exceptions or reversals. <i>A <b>continuous</b> line has no gaps or breaks in it.</i>
<b><u>durable</u></b>	Very long lasting. <i><b>Durable</b> denim jeans.</i>
<b>endless</b>	(of a belt, chain, or tape) having the ends joined to form a loop allowing continuous action. <i><b>Endless</b> waves.</i>
<b><u>enduring</u></b>	Lasting a long time. <i>He formed a number of <b>enduring</b> relationships with women.</i>
<b>equable</b>	Not easily disturbed or angered; calm and even-tempered. <i>An <b>equable</b> temper.</i>

<b>eternity</b>	Used euphemistically to refer to death. <i>A silence that lasted an <b>eternity</b>.</i>
<b>everlasting</b>	Any of various plants of various genera of the family Compositae having flowers that can be dried without loss of form or color. <i>Life <b>everlasting</b>.</i>
<b>immutable</b>	Unchanging over time or unable to be changed. <i>The <b>immutable</b> laws of nature.</i>
<b>incessant</b>	(of something regarded as unpleasant) continuing without pause or interruption. <i>The <b>incessant</b> beat of the music.</i>
<b>incessantly</b>	With unflagging resolve. <i>She talked about him <b>incessantly</b>.</i>
<b>indelible</b>	(of ink or a pen) making marks that cannot be removed. <i>The story made an <b>indelible</b> impression on me.</i>
<b>indestructible</b>	Very long lasting. <i><b>Indestructible</b> plastic containers.</i>
<b>ineradicable</b>	Not able to be destroyed or rooted out. <i><b>Ineradicable</b> hostility.</i>
<b>invariable</b>	(of a quantity) constant. <i>An <b>invariable</b> temperature.</i>
<b>permanence</b>	The state or quality of lasting or remaining unchanged indefinitely. <i>The clarity and <b>permanence</b> of the dyes.</i>
<b>permanency</b>	The property of being able to exist for an indefinite duration.
<b><u>permanent</u></b>	Lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely. <i><b>Permanent</b> address.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	Never ending or changing. <i>A <b>perpetual</b> secretary of the society.</i>
<b><u>stable</u></b>	Shelter in a stable. <i>A <b>stable</b> peace.</i>
<b>unceasing</b>	Not coming to an end; continuous. <i>The <b>unceasing</b> efforts of the staff.</i>
<b><u>unchangeable</u></b>	Not changeable or subject to change-Ashley Montagu. <i>The <b>unchangeable</b> seasons.</i>
<b><u>unchanging</u></b>	Conforming to the same principles or course of action over time. <i>The party stood for <b>unchanging</b> principles.</i>
<b><u>unremitting</u></b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i><b>Unremitting</b> drizzle.</i>
