absurdity	A message whose content is at variance with reason. <i>The crowd laughed at the absurdity of the clown s behavior.</i>
analytic	Of a proposition that is necessarily true independent of fact or experience. <i>A keenly analytic man.</i>
analytical	Using or skilled in using analysis (i.e., separating a whole-intellectual or substantial-into its elemental parts or basic principles. <i>Analytical reasoning.</i>
behaviorism	An approach to psychology that emphasizes observable measurable behavior.
deducible	Capable of being deduced.
deduction	The inference of particular instances by reference to a general law or principle. <i>Tax deductions.</i>
deductive	Relating to logical deduction. <i>I used my deductive powers.</i>
empirical	Relying on medical quackery. <i>Empirical data.</i>
empiricism	The doctrine that knowledge derives from experience.
experimental	Based on experience as opposed to authority or conjecture. <i>An experimental knowledge of God.</i>
extrapolate	Extend (a graph, curve, or range of values) by inferring unknown values from trends in the known data. <i>The figures were extrapolated from past trends.</i>
extrapolation	(mathematics) calculation of the value of a function outside the range of known values. <i>The figure is an extrapolation from prior data.</i>
fatuity	A ludicrous folly.

inductive	Relating to or caused by electric or magnetic induction. <i>Inductive reasoning.</i>
<u>infer</u>	Reason by deduction; establish by deduction. <i>From these facts we can infer that crime has been increasing.</i>
inference	The process of inferring something. <i>Researchers are entrusted with drawing inferences from the data.</i>
logic	The system of operations performed by a computer that underlies the machine's representation of logical operations. <i>By the logic of war.</i>
materialism	The philosophical theory that matter is the only reality. <i>They hated the sinful materialism of the wicked city.</i>
objectively	In a way that is not dependent on the mind for existence; actually. <i>Events should be reported objectively.</i>
observational	Drawing on things that one has seen, heard, or noticed in everyday life. <i>The observational skills of a journalist.</i>
positivism	A humanistic religious system founded on positivism.
ratiocinate	Reason methodologically and logically. <i>A tendency to ratiocinate in isolation.</i>
ratiocination	Logical and methodical reasoning.
rationalism	The doctrine that knowledge is acquired by reason without resort to experience. <i>Scientific rationalism.</i>
reasonable	Able to reason logically. <i>Reasonable prices.</i>
<u>reasoning</u>	The action of thinking about something in a logical, sensible way. <i>He explained the reasoning behind his decision at a media conference.</i>
speculation	A hypothesis that has been formed by speculating or conjecturing (usually with little hard evidence). <i>This is pure speculation on my part.</i>
sylogistic	Of or relating to or consisting of syllogism.
utilitarianism	Doctrine that the useful is the good; especially as elaborated by Jeremy Bentham and James Mill; the aim was said to be the greatest happiness for the greatest number.
<u>verifiable</u>	Capable of being tested (verified or falsified) by experiment or observation. <i>A verifiable account of the incident.</i>
