## Associations of "For mandate" (30 Words)

<b>acts</b>	A New Testament book describing the development of the early church from Christ's Ascension to Paul's sojourn at Rome.
<b>agenda</b>	A plan of things to be done or problems to be addressed. <i>The question of nuclear weapons had been removed from the <b>agenda</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">assembly</a></b>	A group of people elected to make laws or decisions for a particular country or region. <i>A decree guaranteeing freedom of <b>assembly</b>.</i>
<b>authorization</b>	The action of authorizing. <i>Horowitz handed him the <b>authorization</b> signed by Evans.</i>
<b>bailiff</b>	An officer of the court who is employed to execute writs and processes and make arrests etc.
<b>bicameral</b>	Composed of two legislative bodies. <i>The <b>bicameral</b> heart of a fish.</i>
<b>bipartisan</b>	Involving the agreement or cooperation of two political parties that usually oppose each other's policies. <i><b>Bipartisan</b> support.</i>
<b>bureaucracy</b>	The officials in a bureaucracy considered as a group or hierarchy. <i>The unnecessary <b>bureaucracy</b> in local government.</i>
<b>caucus</b>	Of a voter attend an electoral caucus especially on behalf of a particular candidate. <i>Mr Kerry attended the morning <b>caucus</b> in the Old Senate Chamber where his fellow Democrats selected the new minority leadership.</i>
<b>committee</b>	In the UK the whole House of Commons when sitting as a committee. <i>The housing <b>committee</b>.</i>
<b>congress</b>	(often in names) a political society or organization. <i>Sexual <b>congress</b>.</i>

<b>congressional</b>	Belonging or relating to a national legislative body, especially that of the US. <i>The document surfaced in a <b>congressional</b> hearing last year.</i>
<b>enactment</b>	A legal document codifying the result of deliberations of a committee or society or legislative body. <i><b>Enactments</b> covering food safety.</i>
<b>federal</b>	Any federal law enforcement officer. <i><b>Federal</b> courts.</i>
<b>judiciary</b>	The judicial authorities of a country; judges collectively. <i>The independence of the <b>judiciary</b>.</i>
<b>juridical</b>	Of or relating to the law or jurisprudence. <i>Clear words are a matter of practical rather than <b>juridical</b> significance.</i>
<b>lawful</b>	Of a child born within a lawful marriage. <i><b>Lawful</b> methods of dissent.</i>
<b>legal</b>	Having legal efficacy or force. <i>The European <b>legal</b> system.</i>
<b>legality</b>	The quality or state of being in accordance with the law. <i>Documentation testifying to the <b>legality</b> of the arms sale.</i>
<b>legislator</b>	A person who makes laws; a member of a legislative body. <i>24 incumbent <b>legislators</b> lost their seats.</i>
<b>legislature</b>	The legislative body of a country or state. <i>The Nevada state <b>legislature</b> passed a law to prohibit dumping of nuclear waste.</i>
<b>legitimate</b>	Make an illegitimate child legitimate declare the legitimacy of someone. <i>A <b>legitimate</b> male heir.</i>
<b>legitimately</b>	In a lawfully recognized manner. <i>Consumers could <b>legitimately</b> claim to have been misled.</i>
<b>licit</b>	Authorized, sanctioned by, or in accordance with law. <i>Usage patterns differ between <b>licit</b> and <b>illicit</b> drugs.</i>
<b>parliament</b>	The members of Parliament between one dissolution and the next. <i>The Russian <b>parliament</b>.</i>
<b>policy</b>	Written contract or certificate of insurance. <i>You should have read the small print on your <b>policy</b>.</i>
<b>polity</b>	The form of government of a social organization. <i>A vision of a plural Arab <b>polity</b>.</i>
<b>right</b>	A blow given with the right fist. <i>The <b>right</b> time to act.</i>
