judiciary	The judicial authorities of a country; judges collectively. <i>The independence of the judiciary.</i>	
juridical	Of or relating to the law or jurisprudence. <i>Clear words are a matter of practical rather than</i> juridical significance.	
<u>lawful</u>	Of a child born within a lawful marriage. <i>Lawful</i> methods of dissent.	
legal	Having legal efficacy or force. The European legal system.	
legality	The quality or state of being in accordance with the law. Documentation testifying to the legality of the arms sale.	
legislator	A person who makes laws; a member of a legislative body. 24 incumbent legislator s lost their seats.	
legislature	The legislative body of a country or state. <i>The Nevada state</i> legislature <i>passed a law to prohibit dumping of nuclear waste.</i>	
legitimate	Make an illegitimate child legitimate declare the legitimacy of someone. A legitimate male heir.	
legitimately	In a lawfully recognized manner. Consumers could legitimately claim to have been misled.	
licit	Authorized, sanctioned by, or in accordance with law. Usage patterns differ between licit and il licit drugs.	
parliament	The members of Parliament between one dissolution and the next. <i>The Russian parliament</i> .	
policy	Written contract or certificate of insurance. You should have read the small print on your policy .	
polity	The form of government of a social organization. A vision of a plural Arab polity .	
right	A blow given with the right fist. <i>The right time to act.</i>
